THE BOARD ADOPTS THE 2008 BUDGET

The Oakland County Board of Commissioners recently adopted the proposed recommended 2008 Fiscal Year Budget of \$708.9 million at the September 20, 2007 Oakland County Board of Commissioners meeting. This budget will help maintain the quality of life that has made Oakland County a great place to work, play, prosper, and live.

EXPANSION OF THE TETHER PROGRAM MAY OFFER JAIL OVERCROWDING RELIEF

The Oakland County Board of Commissioners are working diligently with the county's judicial and law enforcement branch of government to look at alternatives to jail overcrowding. One effort is to implement a pilot tether program that would allow certain inmates who cannot afford bond or have been sentenced to certain non-violent crimes to be released on tethers.

Those participating in the tether program would have to wear a tether until they have completed the sentence for their crime. During that time, they would be monitored closely by law enforcement authorities. If successful, the tether program would free up jail beds by making tethers available free of charge to low-income offenders. Cost for our current tether program is approximately \$500 a month per offender. The Board has been asked to allocate \$150,000 for this 6 month test pilot program by the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council.
