

Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing (HPRP) program

Oakland County Community & Home Improvement has received federal funds for the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing (HPRP) program. The intent of the HPRP funding is to prevent homelessness and to quickly re-house those who have become homeless. It will be directed to those who would be homeless without this assistance, and to those who are able to remain stably housed once the assistance has ended. Eligible applicants will have to meet several minimum qualifications.

The assistance available to those who qualify may include: rental assistance, utility assistance, security and utility deposits, moving cost assistance, case management, and housing search and placement services.
