

REQUESTS FOR ACCOMMODATIONS

- ❖ The Sixth Judicial Circuit Court wants to assure that qualified individuals with disabilities have equal and full access to the judicial system.
- ❖ Any requests for accommodations may be presented ex parte in writing, on a form approved by the State Court Administrative Office, and provided by the court. Applications should be made to the Court Administrator's Office or to the judge or judicial officer who will preside over the proceeding.
- ❖ All applications for accommodations should include a description of the accommodation sought along with a statement of the functional impairment that necessitates such accommodation.
- ❖ Applications should be made at least 10 working days in advance of the requested accommodations implementation date.

SIGN LANGUAGE/HEARING IMPAIRED INTERPRETERS

- ❖ The court provides a list of qualified interpreters which is updated once a year and is distributed to the Circuit and Probate Judges and staff, District Court Judges and Administrators, and various other County and State Departments.
- ❖ When an interpreter is required please contact the Judge's chamber who is hearing the case and they will arrange one for you.
