Category III Jury Trial	5 Points Maximum 30 Points
Dispositive Motions granted resulting in the dismissal of charges or case	2 points
Category IV Jury Trial	5 Points Maximum 30 Points
20 or more Criminal Defense Jury Trials	10 Points Maximum 10 Points
10 or more Criminal Defense Jury Trials	5 Points Maximum 5 points
10 or more Criminal Defense Non-Jury Trials	5 Points Maximum 5 Points
