LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Some Oakland County school districts have Student Assistance Programs or similar school-based programs. They have been established to enable schools to provide quality education while offering a mechanism to identify youth experiencing or at high risk for personal problems which interfere with academic and/or social development. Once evaluations are completed, referrals are made for appropriate in-school or community-based assistance. Problems which lead to referrals may include, but are not limited to, substance abuse, depression, suicide, incest, family violence, family problems, or health-related issues. Resident Assistance Programs tend to vary from district to district, as they are usually developed to fit the needs of a particular school district. While the Student Assistance Programs in several districts are comprehensive, a few are specifically substance abuse related. Many programs extend to all grade levels (K-12), but some may focus their efforts at specific grade levels. Business/Education Partnerships: Contractual agreements between businesses and school district for reciprocal services. Examples: Oakland General Hospital provides site and expertise for Ward Security Program offered by Madison Heights Community Education.

Volunteer Programs: Community Education programs train and utilize the services of volunteers for a variety of activities.

Job Training Partnership Act Programs: Adult education offices are the site of government-sponsored Job Training and Placement Programs.

Industrial Plant Programs: Community Education provides instruction of various kinds in the work site. Examples: Adult literacy programs, English As A Second Language, or industry designed training.

SAT/ACT Test Prep: Community Education offers prep courses for these national aptitude tests given to high school aged juniors and seniors.
