CLIENT ELIGIBILITY: Children referred by the Michigan Family Independence Agency. Services provided to children and families separated by the M.F.I.A., Family Division of Circuit Court or police, as a result of abuse and/or neglect. Services are provided to those children and families placed within the program.

SERVICES PROVIDED: Recruitment and certification of foster homes, placement of youth in foster-home settings, therapy to families, psychiatric and psychological evaluations and consultations, and case-management services, which include referrals for assistance, adoption services, and independent-living services. Programs include services to juvenile offenders, crisis in-home intervention, and family-focused community-based services to "at risk" families.

CLIENT FEES: None.

INTAKE PROCEDURES: Upon the placement of a youth within our program, an intake on the family is conducted and the appropriate recommendations and planning for services are determined.

VOLUNTEERS: Ages 18 years of age or older for helping children with educational, recreational, and vocational programs.

FUNDED BY: State of Michigan as a licensed child-placing agency.
