*CLIENT ELIGIBILITY:* Jewish children ages 7-16 and their families. Silverman Village - emotionally disturbed children ages 7-12, with no restrictions based on religion. Eligibility requirements may vary depending on particular program. Services the tri-county area.

*SERVICES PROVIDED:* The Fresh Air Society directs three resident camps, Camp Maas in Ortonville (Northern Oakland County), Camp Kennedy in the Upper Peninsula, and Agree Outpost Camp in Northern Ontario. In the summertime, F.A.S. offers a non-sectarian resident camping program for emotionally impaired children entering 2-12 grades. In the non-summer months, there are year-round Jewish family programs, and week-long Outdoor Education Programs for elementary school students who come up to camp for one week at a time. In addition, there are five winterized units with separate dining facilities at Camp Maas that are available for rental by community groups and organizations.
