CLIENT ELIGIBILITY: Waterford residents from 11-18 years old with substance abuse, behavioral, and/or mental health problems.

SERVICES PROVIDED: Substance abuse groups (education and treatment), mental health (individual, family, and group), drug testing, case management services, school visits, daily and weekly monitoring, and positive activities.

CLIENT FEES: Sliding fee scale for treatment and mental health. Free drug testing.

INTAKE PROCEDURES: Parents/adolescents may call. Schools or police can make referrals.

FUNDED BY: Office of Substance Abuse, Office of Juvenile Justice, and Office of Drug Control Policy.
