*CLIENT ELIGIBILITY:* Residents of communities participating in the Oakland County Community Development Block Grant Program.

*SERVICES PROVIDED:* Oakland County Community Development Block Grants Program - The Community Development Office coordinates a program for improvements in local communities such as street repairs, sewers, downtown revitalization, and park development. Fifty communities participate in the County Block Grant Program.

Home Improvement Program - Finances home improvements for low and moderate-income county residents in Block Grant communities.

Emergency Shelter Grants Program - Funds certain operating and public service expenses of emergency shelters for the homeless.

Home Investment Partnerships Act Program - Finances home improvements for low-income residents in Block Grant Communities. Funds community housing development organizations to develop affordable housing for low-income persons.

Housing Counseling - Provides counseling services regarding evictions, security deposit returns, substandard housing, reverse mortgages for seniors, and fair housing practices.
