CLIENT ELIGIBILITY: Adult education programs open to students' 16 years of age and older (16 as of September 1 of the school year).

SERVICES PROVIDED: English as a second language, GED preparation, high school completion, career training programs, and adult basic education/literacy.

CLIENT FEES: ESL classes free to all foreign born students whose English language skills are below state-approved literacy guidelines. High school completion and GED preparation classes are free to students without a high school diploma. Adult basic education/literacy classes are free to all students whose reading and/or math test scores are below 8th grade levels. Tuition fees are \$150-155 for a 60-hour traditional class. \$170-175 for a 60-hour computer class.

INTAKE PROCEDURES: Meeting with program advisor and testing for placement/eligibility.

VOLUNTEERS: To assist in ESL and literacy programs.

FUNDED BY: State and federal grants.
