

Oakland County Circuit Court Tour Policies:

ATTN: Teachers, please go over these policies with your students prior to coming to the Court for your tour.

Please remember the Courthouse is a **VERY IMPORTANT PLACE OF BUSINESS!**

If you or your class can not conform to our policies you will be asked to leave the courtroom and possibly the courthouse; this may affect your classes in the forthcoming years to participate in our tour program.

1. Teachers/students are **not permitted** to bring cameras, camera phones, media devices, metal/sharp objects into the Courthouse.
2. All visitors are to conform to the Court Rule for courthouse decorum; please see attached ORDER.
3. While visiting a courtroom there is to be no talking, sleeping, slouching, gum chewing, eating or drinking. If this happens, you will be asked to leave the courtroom.
4. If a school has had the opportunity to observe a trial in our courthouse, we ask that the teacher and students **DO NOT** discuss the case they have observed until **AFTER** they leave the courthouse.
5. When entering the courtroom, students and teachers are to remain silent, go directly to a seat and sit, we do not want to disrupt the Judge or the Jury.
6. Teachers and students **MUST** be quiet in the hallways/stairwells of the courthouse when going to a courtroom or down to the basement, there are other courts in session and we do not want to disturb their proceedings.

Please remember that this a courthouse; if you can not abide by our rules we observe the right to ask you to leave our place of business and this may affect your future visits to our courthouse.
