PROBATE JUDGE LINDA S. HALLMARK HONORED

Oakland County, MI (February 6, 2007) – The Honorable Linda S. Hallmark, Oakland County Probate Judge, was recognized for her outstanding work and celebrated for her achievements at the first annual Salute to Justice dinner honoring ten distinguished Michigan Judges of Lebanese descent. The event, hosted by the Lebanese American Chamber of Commerce, was held on January 31, 2007 at the Farmington Hills Manor.

Judge Hallmark presently serves as a Probate judge in the Circuit Court family division. Judge Hallmark was appointed to the Probate bench by then-Governor John Engler in 1997 and served as Chief Judge of the Probate Court in 2000. She received her Bachelor of Science Degree from Michigan State University and her Juris Doctorate Degree from Wayne State University Law School. Judge Hallmark is a member of the State Bar, Federal Bar Association, Oakland County Bar Association, U.S. Supreme Court Bar, Michigan Interprofessional Association, State Bar Association Fellows, Women Lawyers Association, and Women Official's Network Board of Directors. In addition, she was past chair of the State Bar Family Law Section Council and Oakland County Family Law Committee, and has served on the Governor's Task Force for Children's Justice since 1993.
