

YOUTH ASSISTANCE SUMMIT - PHASE II FEEDBACK FORM

At the Youth Assistance Summit – Phase II we presented three alternative structure and funding ideas for Oakland County Youth Assistance. All three of these scenarios are included in the YA Summit - Phase II Power Point Presentation, which can be found on the Oakland County Youth Assistance website.

Below is a brief summary of each proposal and space for you to comment on each one.

- A. As presented by George Miller, Director of Oakland County Department of Health and Human Services, proposal A would consolidate YA offices and create 7 regional offices in order to provide services for youth exiting residential placement as well as prevention services.

- B. As presented by Pamela Davis, Manager of Court Services of the Circuit Court - Family Division, proposal B would maintain 26 YA offices throughout the county. 25% of each caseworkers' time would be dedicated to providing services for youth exiting residential placement

- C. As presented by Judge Young, proposal C would involve passing a countywide millage with funds dedicated to fund and enhance Youth Assistance Services.
