Pitch In to Be a Poll Worker: It's easy as 1-2-3 ...

- First you'll attend a training session to learn how to be a poll worker. Then, you're ready to go to work. You will be paid to attend training if you work.
- On Election Day, you'll help set up the polling site before your neighbors arrive.
- Finally, you'll check voters in at the precinct and issue ballots. Once the day is over, you and your fellow election workers will close the polling place.

working a full day on
Election Day and
up to \$25 for pre- Election Day
training.
