PROPOSAL(S):

I. OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will approve a millage levy within the maximum statutory rate of 18 mills on all property except principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, exempting therefrom principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property as defined by law, in Fenton Area Public Schools, Genesee, Livingston and Oakland Counties, Michigan, be increased by 17.9299 mills (\$17.9299 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for the year 2007, to provide funds for operating purposes (17.4299 mills of the above is a renewal of millage which expired with the 2006 tax levy and .5 mill is a restoration of millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963); the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2007 is approximately \$5,045,164?

II. OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property except principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, exempting therefrom principal residence, qualified agricultural property and qualified forest property as defined by law, in Fenton Area Public Schools, Genesee, Livingston and Oakland Counties, Michigan, be increased by .0701 mill (\$0.0701 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for the year 2007, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2007 is approximately \$19,725 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?
