PROPOSAL(S):

**RECREATIONAL FACILITIES BONDING PROPOSITION**

Shall the City of Berkley, County of Oakland, Michigan, borrow the principal amount of not to exceed \$15,000,000 and issue in one or more series its unlimited tax general obligation bonds to pay the cost of acquiring, constructing and equipping improvements to the City's recreational facilities including its community center and swimming pool together with parking and other related facilities and the costs of issuance of said bonds? The estimated mills to be levied in 2010 are \$1.1492 mills (\$1.1492 per \$1,000 taxable value). The estimated average millage rate required to retire the bonds is \$2.0194 mills (\$2.0194 per \$1,000 taxable value). The maximum number of years any series of bonds may be outstanding is twenty (20) years.

**CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSITION**

Shall Section 9.4 of the Charter of the City of Berkley be amended to increase the amount of taxation permitted to be levied against property in the City by .15 percent of the assessed valuation of all real and personal property subject to taxation which increased tax is to be devoted exclusively to the construction, improvement, operation and maintenance of City recreational facilities? It is estimated that in 2010 which is the first year the increased tax is to be levied additional revenues of \$770,928 will be collected.
