

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF COMMERCE
PRIMARY ELECTION – AUGUST 3, 2010**

**Township Wide Fire Protection Special Assessment Ballot Proposal
(Including the Village of Wolverine Lake)**

Shall the Charter Township of Commerce fund Fire Protection operations and supporting structures, equipment, and related costs for a period of 10 years by the levy of a new special assessment under Act 33 of 1951, as amended, in an amount of up to 2 mills (\$2.00 for each \$1000 of real property taxable value) per year on the real property located within Commerce Township (including real property within the Village of Wolverine Lake)? The estimated maximum amount of revenue that could be collected in the first year the millage is authorized and levied could be \$3,408,585.

**Township Wide Police Protection Special Assessment Ballot Proposal
(Not including the Village of Wolverine Lake)**

Shall the Charter Township of Commerce fund Police Protection operations and supporting structures, equipment, and related costs, within that portion of the township outside of the Village of Wolverine Lake, by the levy of a new special assessment under Act 33 of 1951, as amended, for a period of 10 years in an amount of up to 2.7 mills (\$2.70 for each \$1000 of real property taxable value) per year on the real property located within Commerce Township, and outside of the Village of Wolverine Lake? The estimated maximum amount of revenue that could be collected in the first year the millage is authorized and levied could be \$4,229,717.
