**PROPOSALS
GENERAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 8, 2011**

CITY OF BIRMINGHAM

CHARTER AMENDMENT I

The proposed Amendment to Section 4 would change deadlines for filing nominating petitions from the seventh Tuesday to the twelfth Tuesday prior to the election. This Amendment would make the Charter consistent with State law.

Shall the Birmingham Charter, Chapter IV, Registrations, Nominations and Elections, Section 4, be amended to be consistent with state law standardizing filing deadlines for candidates for public office?

CHARTER AMENDMENT II

The proposed Amendment to Section 12 would bring the City's election ballots into compliance with State Ballot Production Standards whereby voters are required to darken an oval instead of checking a square to cast their vote for a candidate or issue. This Amendment would make the Charter consistent with state ballot standards.

Shall the Birmingham Charter, Chapter IV, Registrations, Nominations and Elections, Section 12, be amended to be consistent with the State of Michigan Ballot Production Standards related to Optical Scan Ballots?

CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS

LIBRARY MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the City of Bloomfield Hills be authorized to levy a new library millage of .39 mills per year for a period of three years commencing with the July, 2012 levy to fund a library contract with the Baldwin Public Library of Birmingham, Michigan, to provide library services for the residents of the City of Bloomfield Hills? Library services would include full library privileges to the Baldwin Library, including borrowing privileges and other services of the Baldwin Library on the same basis as the same are available to residents of the City of Birmingham. Approval of this proposal would permit a tax limitation levy of \$.39 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the City. The amount of revenue the City of Bloomfield Hills will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the City in the first calendar year is estimated to be \$289,363.

CITY OF FARMINGTON

Charter Amendment Proposal 1

Shall the Farmington City Charter, Section 8.2, involving budget procedures, be amended removing the requirement that the budget include proposed expenditures for the former municipal court, which no longer exists; removing the requirement that the budget include proposed expenditures and anticipated revenue for the partial period from July 1 to March 1, while leaving in place the requirement that the budget still cover the entire fiscal year as required by law; and removing the limitation that the budget include an estimate of anticipated revenues only from sources "other than taxes," thus requiring the estimate to also include taxes?

Charter Amendment Proposal 2

Shall the Farmington City Charter, Section 8.4, relating to the adoption of the budget, be amended to change the date by which the budget must be adopted by the City Council from the first Monday in June each year to June 21 each year, and the date by which the City Manager shall prepare and submit the budget to City Council from the third Monday in April to April 21 of each year?

Charter Amendment Proposal 3

Shall the Farmington City Charter, Section 8.5, relating to budget control, be amended to remove the statement that the Council may transfer unencumbered appropriation balances from one department, fund, or agency to another; to remove the statement that the budget appropriation balances not encumbered by the end of the fiscal year revert to the general fund; and to remove the language authorizing the Council to make additional appropriations only in case of emergency or unanticipated expenditure, and to replace the removed language with language authorizing the amendment of the budget by resolution in accordance with state laws?

Charter Amendment Proposal 4

Shall the Farmington City Charter, Section 8.6, relating to the authorized depository of city funds, be amended to delete the language referring to the city providing for "security" for its deposits while leaving in place language that requires the depository of city funds to be authorized by the City Council in accordance with state law?

Charter Amendment Proposal 5

Shall the Farmington City Charter, Section 8.7, relating to the required annual financial report and independent audit thereof, be amended to remove language stating that "all city accounts shall be audited," and to replace it with language stating that the City Manager's required annual report shall be in the form of a financial report in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and applicable state laws and it is that report that shall be independently audited?

CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS

Charter Amendment Public Safety Millage

Shall the Farmington Hills City Charter be amended to allow an additional special tax rate for public safety functions of the Fire and Police Departments by authorizing the City to levy a new additional millage in the amount of 1.7 mills, for 10 years, starting with the July, 2012 levy (resulting in the authorization to collect an estimated additional \$5,270,000 in the first year if approved and levied), the taxes to be used by the City only for purposes of fire and police staffing and equipment to maintain the current levels of City public safety services?

CITY OF HAZEL PARK

LIBRARY MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the tax limitation imposed on all taxable real and tangible personal property within the City of Hazel Park, Oakland County, Michigan, be increased for said City in an amount not to exceed .48 mill (\$.48 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) in perpetuity beginning in the year 2012, to provide funds for operating, equipping, and funding the Hazel Park Memorial Library and for all other library purposes authorized by law; and shall the City levy such new additional millage for said purpose? The estimate of the revenue the City will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the 2012 calendar year is approximately \$110,000.

CITY OF ORCHARD LAKE VILLAGE

Vacating Portion of Willow Lane

Shall the City of Orchard Lake Village vacate, discontinue and abolish 40 feet of roadway located at the end of Willow Lane, formerly known as Troy Street, in the City of Orchard Lake Village, and then sell the vacated portion of the road?

CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

A proposal to amend the City Charter by adding the following new Section 11.8 – Parks and Open Spaces. If adopted, this section will provide that City-owned parks and open spaces shall be used only for park and open space purposes and shall not be sold, leased, transferred, exchanged or converted to another use unless approved by voters.

Section 11.8 – Parks and Open Spaces

City-owned parks and open spaces shall be used only for park and open space purposes and shall not be sold, leased, transferred, exchanged or converted to another use unless approved by a majority of votes cast by the electors at an election.

.1 “Converted to another use” means changing the use of a park or open space, or significant part thereof, from a recreation or conservation use to another use not directly related or incidental to public recreation or conservation.

.2 This section shall apply to all present and future City-owned property designated as park or open space in the City’s Parks and Recreation Master Plan. The designation of parks or open space shall not be removed or changed without voter approval. The existing use of a park or open space on the effective date of this section shall be considered to be a lawful use for the particular property.

.3 All land acquired by the City with proceeds from the 2005 Millage Proposal to Provide Funding to Permanently Preserve Green Spaces and Natural Features within the City of Rochester Hills shall remain permanently preserved.

Shall the City Charter be amended to add Section 11.8?

CITY OF ROYAL OAK

Charter Amendment Proposal A

Proposed Amendment to Chapter 8, Section 11 (B) of the Royal Oak City Charter to Allow for a Renewal Refuse Collection, Disposal and Curbside Recycling Millage.

The proposed amendment to the Royal Oak Charter, if approved, would allow the City to levy a millage for a period not to exceed five (5) years up to 1.00 mil, to defray the costs of refuse collection, disposal and curbside recycling.

Shall the proposal be adopted?

Charter Amendment Proposal B

Currently, the City Charter at Chapter Three, Section 4, provides that the term of all elective officers commences at 12:00 noon on the first Monday in December following the officers' election. The proposed change would, starting in 2013 and in each subsequent election, end the term at 7:30 pm on the third Monday in November following the next election for that office. Starting in 2017 and in each subsequent election, the term would commence at 7:30 pm on the third Monday in November following the elective officers' election.

Shall the proposal be adopted?

Charter Amendment Proposal C

The proposed changes to the Charter at Chapter Four, Section 2, if adopted, would make it clear that the Charter recognizes state law for filing deadlines concerning nominating petitions for prospective candidates for city elective office.

Shall the proposal be adopted?

Charter Amendment Proposal D

Currently, the City Charter at Chapter Four, Section 2, requires a filing fee to be paid to the City Treasurer on behalf of each candidate not later than 4:00 p.m. of the ninth Tuesday preceding the election in question. The proposed changes, if adopted, would require the filing fee to be paid to the City Treasurer no later than the same date and time required for prospective candidates for elective office to file their nominating petitions.

Shall the proposal be adopted?

CITY OF SYLVAN LAKE

PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE

This amendment will authorize the levy of new additional millage in the amount of not to exceed 5.0 mills for 10 years, 2012 through 2021, inclusive, for public safety purposes, including police and fire protection services. It is estimated that if levied, 5.0 mills would raise approximately \$385,026 when first levied in 2012.

Shall the proposed amendment be adopted?

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WEST BLOOMFIELD

PROPOSAL FOR PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the previously authorized Police and Fire tax levy by The Charter Township of West Bloomfield of up to 3.1378 mills or less, as reduced by required millage rollbacks, be renewed after it expires in 2011 for a period of ten years, from 2012 through 2021? The renewed millage is exclusively for the costs and expenses of the Township Public Safety (Police, Fire, EMS and Dispatch) Departments. Approval of this proposal would renew the tax limitation levy of 3.1378 mills or less if reduced by millage rollback (\$3.1378 per \$1000 of taxable value) on all taxable property in the Township. It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect up to \$9,948,842 in the first year if approved and levied.

PROPOSAL FOR PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE INCREASE

Shall The Charter Township of West Bloomfield be authorized to increase the levy of taxes by up to 2.85 mills for a period of 11 years from 2011 through 2021? The increased millage is exclusively for the costs and expenses of the Township Public Safety (Police, Fire, EMS and Dispatch) Departments. Approval of this proposal would authorize a tax limitation increase of 2.85 mills (\$2.85 per \$1000 of taxable value) on all taxable property in the Township. It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect up to \$9,036,331 in the first year if approved and levied.

ALMONT COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSITION EXEMPTING PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE AND QUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL PROPERTY

This millage will allow the school district to continue to levy not more than the statutory rate of 18 mills against non-principal residence and non-qualified agricultural property required for the school district to continue to receive its full revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all taxable property except principal residence and qualified agricultural property as defined by law, in Almont Community Schools, Counties of Lapeer, St. Clair, Macomb and Oakland, be increased by 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of two (2) years, 2011 and 2012, inclusive, to provide in part the funds to operate and maintain the school system? It is estimated that the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the 2011 calendar year will be approximately \$849,651 from the local taxes authorized in this proposal. The proposed millage is a renewal of a previously authorized millage of 18 mills.

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal, if approved by the electors, will allow the School District of the City of Birmingham to continue to levy up to 7.980 mills for general operating purposes (a reduction from the 8.460 mills previously authorized by the electors) on all taxable property in the School District to the extent that such property is not exempt from such levy. Under existing law, the School District would levy only that portion of the mills on taxable property necessary to allow the School District to receive the full revenue per pupil foundation allowance permitted by the State. The School District is not currently levying the 7.980 mills on personal residences (owner-occupied homes).

Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except property exempted by law, situated within the School District of the City of Birmingham, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, be increased as provided in the Michigan Constitution, in the amount of 7.980 mills (\$7.98 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for a period of ten (10) years, from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2022, inclusive, with 7.980 mills of the above being a renewal of millage which would otherwise expire on June 30, 2012? This millage would provide estimated revenues to the School District of the City of Birmingham of Six Million Six Hundred Thousand (\$6,600,000) Dollars during the 2012 calendar year, to be used for general operating purposes, if approved and levied.

MADISON DISTRICT PULBIC SCHOOLS

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2011 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 19 mills (\$19.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Madison District Public Schools, Oakland County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2012 to 2016, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2012 is approximately \$1,651,312 (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2011 tax levy)?

MACOMB INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT

REGIONAL ENHANCEMENT SPECIAL EDUCATION OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Pursuant to state law, the revenue raised by the proposed enhancement millage will be collected by the Macomb Intermediate School District and allocated in accordance with Section 705 of the Revised School Code to local public school districts within the boundaries of the Macomb Intermediate School District for special education purposes with such revenue allocation being applied first to pay unfunded balance of the costs which would otherwise be payable by each local school district to the Macomb Intermediate School District for certain special education center programs.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Macomb Intermediate School District, Michigan, be increased by 1.2 mill (\$1.20 per thousand dollars of taxable value) for a period of twenty (20) years, 2011 to 2030, inclusive, as new additional millage to provide operating funds to enhance other state and local funding for local school district special education operating purposes? It is estimated that 1.2 mill would raise approximately \$27.5 million when first levied in 2011.

NORTHVILLE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Northville Public Schools, Wayne, Oakland and Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, be increased by 20.91 mills (\$20.91 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2012 to 2021, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2012 is approximately \$8,044,850 (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2012 tax levy)?

ROMEO COMMUNITY SCHOOLS COUNTIES OF MACOMB AND OAKLAND, MICHIGAN

BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This renewal proposal, if approved by the electors, will allow the Romeo Community Schools to continue to levy a building and site sinking fund millage, the proceeds of which will be used to make infrastructure improvements and repairs to the School District's facilities. Pursuant to State Law, the expenditure of the building and site sinking fund millage proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for teacher, administrator or employee salaries, maintenance or other operating expenses.

Shall the Romeo Community Schools be authorized to levy one and one-quarter (1.25) mills (\$1.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value), for a period of four (4) years, from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2016 to create a building and site sinking fund for the purpose of the construction or repair of school buildings or any other purpose allowed under Michigan law? This millage is a request for a renewal of the voter approved building and site sinking fund tax levy which will expire on June 30, 2012. This millage would provide estimated revenues to the Romeo Community Schools of approximately One Million Nine Hundred Thousand and 00/100 (\$1,900,000.00) Dollars during the 2012 calendar year, if approved and levied.

FARMINGTON COMMUNITY LIBRARY

Library Millage Renewal Proposal

Shall the Farmington Community Library, Oakland County, Michigan, renew the previously authorized millage rate that expires in 2012, in an amount not to exceed 0.5856 mill (\$0.5856 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) on all taxable property (real and tangible personal) within the Farmington Community Library District (comprised of the Cities of Farmington and Farmington Hills) for a period of twenty (20) years, beginning in the year 2013 and ending in the year 2032, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all District Library purposes authorized by law, including but not limited to funds for the ongoing maintenance and operation of the Main Library and the Farmington Branch in order to offer materials, resources, services, programs and technology, and maintain its facilities? The estimate of revenue the District Library would collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Farmington Community Library in the 2013 calendar year is approximately \$2,100,000.

A portion of the revenue collected may be subject to capture by the City of Farmington Brownfield Redevelopment Authority and Downtown Development Authority and the City of Farmington Hills Brownfield Redevelopment Authority, as provided by law.
