

## **Pretrial Supervision**

### ***AMS "Alcohol Tether" Rules and Regulations***

Defendants who fail to comply with the following rules may be subject to a warrant being issued for their arrest, or a hearing being held to revoke their bond. Those who are violated in a court of law could have their bond forfeited and a new higher bond issued.

1. Defendants can make contact with the Pretrial Supervision (PTS) Tether Unit at 2300 Dixie Hwy, Suite 200, Waterford, MI 48328. The main phone number is (248)-451-2331.
2. Defendants will comply with all instructions from the PTS Tether Unit and/or HAS staff. Defendants will return all calls from PTS Tether Unit and/or HAS immediately. Defendants agree that they may be required to report for equipment checks, which may result in lost work.
3. Defendants are to understand that all tether information will be retained as an official record.
4. Defendants are required to maintain a working landline telephone for purposes of the AMS tether. Defendants agree to remove the following services from their telephones: call waiting, call forwarding, caller ID, and third party capabilities. Voicemail and answering machines are acceptable.
5. The AMS tether will have a scheduled call out time and the defendant is required to be at home and within range of the modem for 15 minutes prior to the call out time and 15 minutes after the call out time. The defendant must be within 3 feet of the modem for the modem to call out properly. The closer the defendant is to the modem, the faster the modem will call out.
6. Defendants who need to change residences must provide a minimum of 24 hours notice to the PTS Tether Unit and must have a working land line telephone service prior to changing residences.
7. Defendants are not allowed to go swimming, take a bath, or submerge the bracelet in water. Defendants are allowed to take a shower. After showering, the defendant must dry the tether as well as possible including under the bracelet to reduce the risk of skin irritation. The defendant is allowed to use a hair dryer to briefly blow over and dry any excess water from the bracelet.
8. Defendants are not allowed to put anything between the leg and the bracelet. The bracelet should not be loose on the ankle and should not be moved up and down or turned around on the ankle. Shoes, boots, clothing, etc must not interfere with the bracelet position on the ankle.
9. **Defendants cannot consume any alcohol.** Defendants cannot use any products that contain alcohol. Defendants MUST READ ALL LABELS AND INGREDIENTS PRIOR TO USING ANY PRODUCTS. Examples of products that the defendant cannot use are: any aerosol sprays, cologne, perfume, after shave, shaving cream/lotion, hair spray, hair gel, mouthwash (unless alcohol free), breath sprays, Listerine Strips or any spray/liquid breath freshener. BEWARE of household cleaning products; do not use any products that contain alcohol to clean unless rubber gloves are worn. **Defendants are to understand that the AMS tether will detect anything that is ingested or comes in contact with their skin.**
10. Defendants may be requested to allow inspection of the tether equipment in their home by House Arrest Services or any other appropriate agency.
11. Defendants will follow the payment schedule that is required by House Arrest Services. Defendants will be allowed to mail in payments or drop them off directly. Payments will be made to House Arrest Services located at 16039 East 9 Mile Road Eastpointe, Mi. 48021. Payments must be made by cash, money order or credit card (credit cards subject to \$5.00 fee). Personal checks will **not** be accepted. .

12. Upon successful completion of the program, defendants and/or family members must contact the PTS Tether Unit to schedule an appointment to have their equipment removed by House Arrest Services. For defendant's who are violated and /or incarcerated, the ankle bracelet will be removed by booking officers. All equipment must be returned to House Arrest Services. Failure to return the equipment could lead to additional daily charges, as well as prosecution for theft.
