Sealed proposals will be received by the Drainage Board for the George W. Kuhn Drain, Oakland County, Michigan, at the Office of the Oakland County Drain Commissioner, Building 95 West, One Public Works Drive, Waterford, Michigan 48328-1907 for the construction of certain facilities and structures, including the following approximate quantities:

10,600 linear feet of 20-inch diameter ductile iron flushing water main, 8,400 linear feet of 12-inch diameter ductile iron flushing water header, replacing 1,900 service saddle connections to the flushing header, screen building modifications, pump station modifications, traffic control, restoration and related Work.

Proposals will be received up to 1:00 p.m., local time, on the date set forth herein at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read.

PROPOSAL TO BE RECEIVED: Tuesday, July 15, 2008

Bidders shall review and comply with the Information For Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Information For Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for receipt will not be considered.

Starting on Monday, June 16, 2008, the Drawings and Specifications under which the work will be done will be on file and may be examined at the Office of the Oakland County Drain Commissioner at One Public Works Drive, Waterford, Michigan, the Construction Association of Michigan, Reed Construction Data, Electronic Plan Room and McGraw Hill Construction – Dodge. Copies thereof may be obtained for a non-refundable fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) if picked up or one hundred twenty-five (\$125.00) dollars if mailed, (Check Only) for each set of Contract Documents from the Office of **Wade Trim Associates, Inc., 25251 Northline Road, Taylor, Michigan 48180**.

A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for June 30, 2008 at 9:00 am local time at the Red Oaks Youth Soccer Complex, 29601 John R. Road, Madison Heights, Michigan, 48071. All prospective bidders are requested to attend this meeting.

This contract is funded with a State Revolving Fund loan. Bidders are required to complete the Certification Regarding Debarment and must comply with the requirements in the contract documents.

A certified or cashier's check or bid bond for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the proposal will be required for each proposal.

The right is reserved by the Owner to accept any proposal, to reject any proposal and to waive irregularities in the proposals.

No bidder may withdraw its bid within 120 days after the actual date of opening thereof.
