

2010 CENSUS NEW CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

October 12, 2009

Attention Oakland County Community Representatives:

The U.S. Census Bureau has provided local government with an opportunity to collaborate on improved address accuracy in support of the 2010 Census. The highest elected official (HEO) of your community has recently received information from the U.S. Census Bureau regarding the 2010 Census New Construction Program. This program is designed to include addresses for new construction that took place after the Census Bureau's canvassing effort which concluded in March, 2009.

Oakland County has identified the criteria for qualifying new construction and can access this information for those communities that have contracted the County to perform its assessing functions. If your community performs its own assessing functions your local assessor will have access to this information.

In either case, you may collaborate with Oakland County to report new construction information to the U.S. Census Bureau for inclusion in the 2010 Census.

Communities that have contracted Oakland County to perform their assessing functions

Oakland County will identify qualifying new construction using open building permits for residential properties issued in January, 2009 or later. These construction sites will be field checked to determine if roofing and installation of doors and windows is expected to be complete by April 1, 2010.

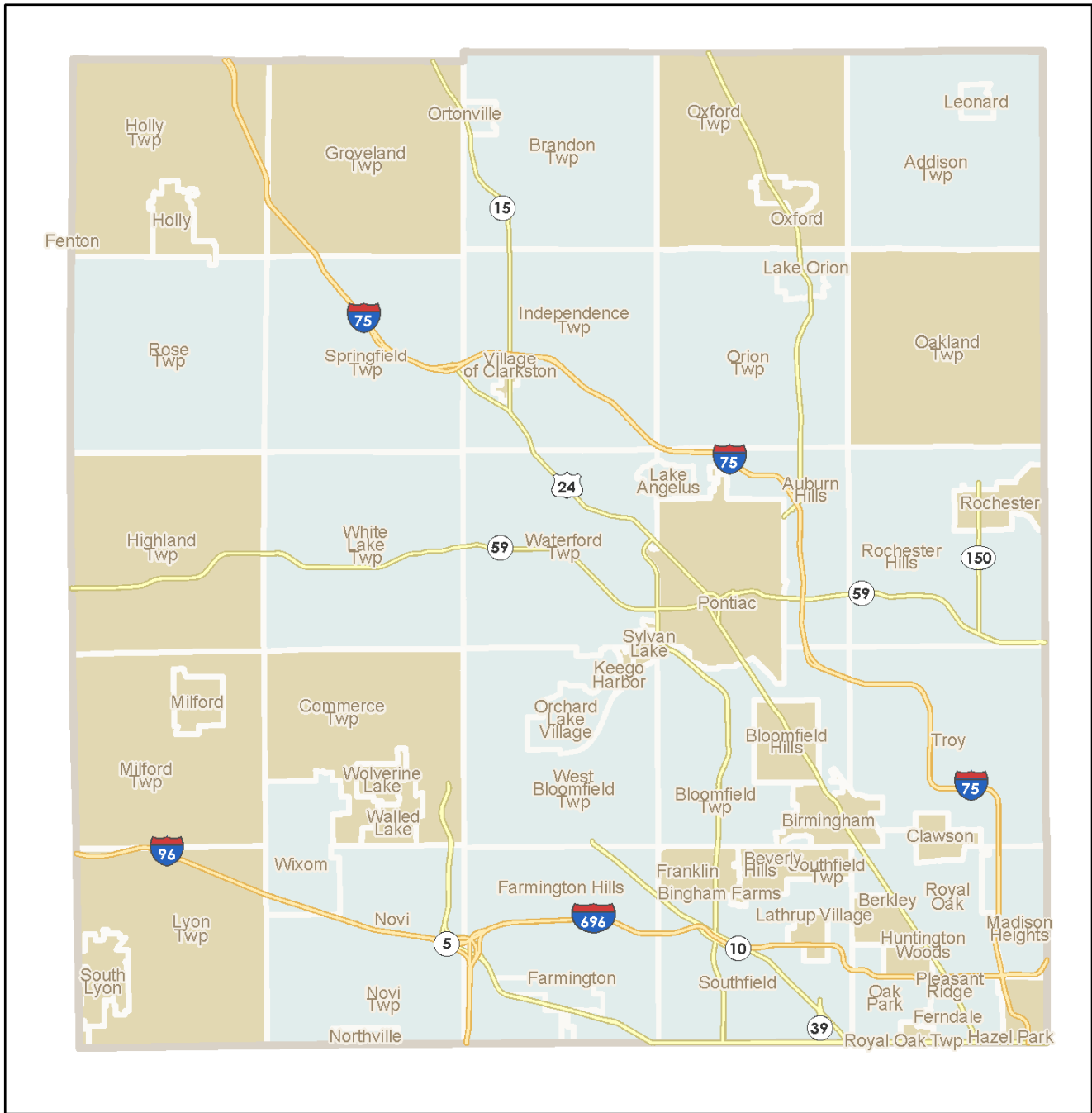

In addition, these construction sites must be expected to have complete installation of roofing, doors and windows by April 1, 2010.
