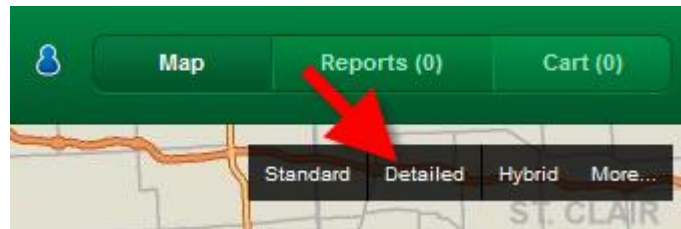


## 2012 Boundary and Annexation Survey (BAS)

By participating in the Consolidated BAS, your community has identified Oakland County as the U. S. Census Bureau liaison for future BAS updates. The maps found in the Property Gateway at the link below include all boundary and road updates the County has identified thus far. By viewing the maps in the Property Gateway, participating communities may validate accuracy and completeness. Municipal boundary changes, roads to add or delete and street name changes may be reported to Oakland County for inclusion with the BAS that will be submitted to the Census Bureau for 2012.

To ensure that Oakland County has ample time to report additional BAS updates to the Census Bureau in accordance with the 2012 BAS Respondent's Guide, **updates must be submitted to Oakland County by Wednesday, February 22, 2012.** Please let us know when you have completed your review even if you do not have updates to report.

You must be a community representative to submit updates. You may submit digital or hard copy edits in plain text description or by providing a map. Please be sure to include your contact information in case further clarification is needed. You may provide updates via the Oakland County Information Technology (OCIT) Service Center, U. S. mail or by hand delivery as shown below. OCIT Service Center phone assistance is available from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except County government holidays. Incidents may be submitted via web or email 24/7. When logging a Service Center incident, the caller must:

- Provide contact name, phone number, email address and agency name
- State that the incident is in regard to the "2012 BAS"
