

Data Warehouse Data Download Instructions

Required Software: Internet browser for FTP client

Data Layers Involved: data_[CVTCode].zip

Purpose

The data_[CVTCode].zip file contains text files that have the data from each of the Data Warehouse tables stored in a tab-delimited format. The delimited files can be used to populate tables in any relational database. The first line in each of the delimited files is the column heading line. Some of the text files may just have one line (the heading line) because the source table is empty.

Tips

- The FTP site is NOT open to the Internet, which means that you MUST be connected to OakNet and have set up your network to resolve the following IP and DNS information:

Fully Qualified Domain Name: Indctxd1p.co.oakland.mi.us

IP Address: 192.168.12.180

Port: TCP/IP – 21

Note: you may need to work with your IT department to allow access to this port.

- The Step-by-Step directions will vary, depending on the client software you are using.

- The refreshed data is generally available every Monday morning by 8 am.

Step-by-Step

1. Open a Web browser such as Internet Explorer, or an FTP client.
2. In the address line, enter <ftp://192.168.12.180> OR <ftp://Indctxd1p.co.oakland.mi.us>.
3. When prompted for a username and password, enter the account information provided to you. If you have forgotten this information, contact the Oakland County Service Center.
4. Browse for the CVTDataExports directory, and locate your community's directory.
5. Open your community's directory.
6. Select the data_[CVTCode].zip (e.g., data_08.zip) file.
7. When prompted, choose to save the file to your hard drive or a network drive.
8. Close your Web browser or FTP client.
