The initial supply of H1N1 vaccine is limited. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has identified a target population to receive this limited supply because they have a higher risk for complications.

The target population includes:

- Pregnant women
- Children and young adults 6 months through 24 years of age
- Caregivers for children under 6 months of age
- Adults 25 through 64 years of age with underlying medical conditions
- Healthcare and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) workers

As a result of the limited supply of the 2009 H1N1 vaccine, flu shots will be provided based on availability. **Pre-enrollment does not guarantee a flu shot at our clinics, but it will reduce required paperwork at the site.** Walk-ins are welcome at our clinics.
