

HEARING SCREENING

Does your child have a problem with hearing?

Some signs to look for:

1. Speech that is difficult to understand
2. Your child may respond to your voice only when facing you
3. Turns the volume up on the TV/radio
4. Needs information repeated
5. Almost always talks in a loud voice
6. Has a history of severe ear infections
7. Responds to directions inappropriately



Hearing screening is conducted in schools for specific preschool and school-age children. Hearing screening appointments are available free of charge at the three Oakland County Health Division offices for children (three years of age through high school) who reside in Oakland County. Parents are welcome to call the Oakland County Health Division's Hearing and Vision Unit at (248) 424-7074 for questions, concerns or an appointment.
