

# VISION SCREENING

## Does your child have problems with vision?

*Some signs to look for:*

1. Rubs eyes frequently
2. Squints when looking at distant objects
3. Complains of blurriness, visual disturbances or discomfort around the eyes
4. Sits close to the television
5. Holds papers close to face
6. Complains of headaches



*Vision screening is conducted in schools for specific preschool and school-age children. Vision screening appointments are available free of charge at the three Oakland County Health Division offices for children (three years of age through high school) who reside in Oakland County. Parents are welcome to call the Health Division's Hearing and Vision Unit at (248) 424-7070 for questions, concerns or an appointment.*
