This is a follow-up to the MASACA meeting held, May 8, 2009. The FAODP exam is no longer available for administration; the new exam is the Michigan Addiction Fundamentals Exam (MAFE.)

The MAFE exam is an entry-level exam based on SAMSHA's Tap 21 and was developed by the Southern Coast Addiction Technology Transfer Center (SCATTC) and the Florida Certification Board (FCB.) Test Metric, Inc. conducted the Role Delineation Study for this exam through contract with SCATTC.

MAFE Examination Information:

- Exam registration fee is \$80 -- Registration forms are available via MCBAP website: www.mcbap.com
- Two hours are allotted to complete the exam
- 100 multiple-choice questions
- 35 specific education contact hours can be earned if passed
- Scoring will be done through Test Metric, Inc.
- Administered in conjunction with the IC&RC exams; offered quarterly in Okemos, Troy, Gaylord and Marquette
- Study Guides will be available soon - information will be posted via MCBAP website
- Next scheduled exam date is Friday, September 11, 2009

Computer Based Testing may be an option in the future. I will be seeking college-testing sites that are familiar with proctoring on-line exams, as Test Metric, Inc. must approve these sites.
