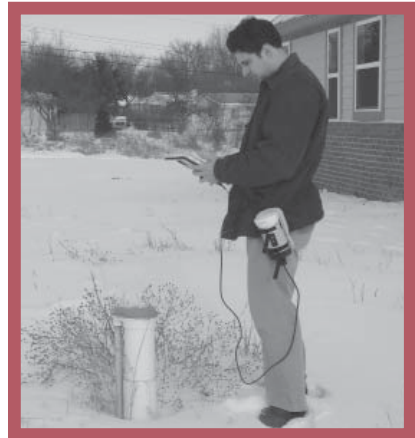

Registered Sanitarians:

- Conduct soil evaluations and issue permits for on-site sewage disposal systems
- Review engineering proposals for on-site sewage disposal systems for commercial and residential building sites
- Evaluate proposed developments utilizing on-site sewage disposal and water well systems
- Conduct GIS mapping of water wells and on-site disposal systems
- Investigate complaints relating to residential and non residential septic systems
- Inspect and monitor septic hauler vehicles and receiving facilities
- Monitor groundwater in areas of contamination
- Issue private, public, (Type II and III) well abandonment and geothermal well permits
- Inspect well installation and conduct water sampling
- Conduct and monitor water and sampling at public beaches
- Inspect and monitor water sampling at public swimming pools and spas
- Conduct inspections of public campgrounds
- Conduct environmental health inspections at licensed adult foster care and childcare facilities
- Plan review for daycare and childcare facilities
- Monitor West Nile Virus Corvids reporting hotline
