

# ***XP Laptop – Enabling Wireless Card***

---

The wireless card included in your laptop will allow you to connect to an unsecured or public wireless access point to access the Internet. Please use the following instructions to enable the wireless card.

To enable the wireless card in your laptop, you must log in as a Local Administrator using the following instructions:

1. From the **Login Screen**, press **Ctrl + Alt + Delete** simultaneously to access the **Microsoft Logon** window.
2. Click the **OK** button to acknowledge the **Oakland County Warning Banner**.
3. From the **Logon** screen, type **laXXXXXX** (where XXXXXX is the device tag number) in the **User name** field.
4. Type **laXXXXXX** in the **Password** field.
5. Click the drop-down arrow next to **Log onto** and choose the local device, **NBXXXXXX**.
6. From the Desktop, right click on **My Network Places** and choose **Properties**.
7. In the **LAN or High-Speed Internet** section, right click on **Wireless Network Connection** and choose **Enable**.
8. Click the **OK** button.

Your wireless card is now enabled and will detect any available wireless Internet connection. If you have any questions regarding the enabling of your wireless card, please call the IT Service Center at (248) 858-8812.
