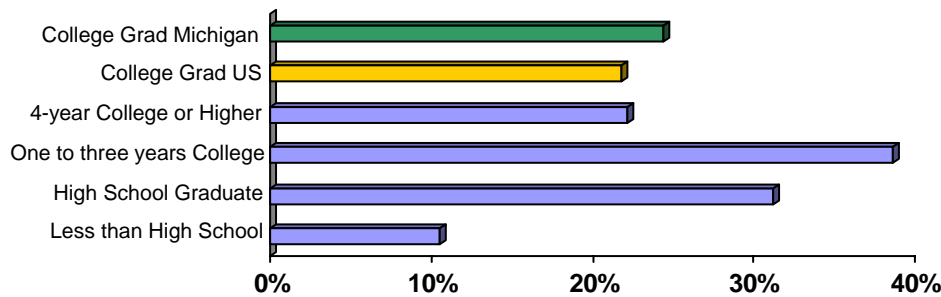

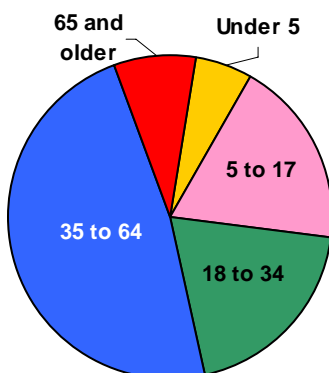
Educational Attainment of People Over 25 Years of Age

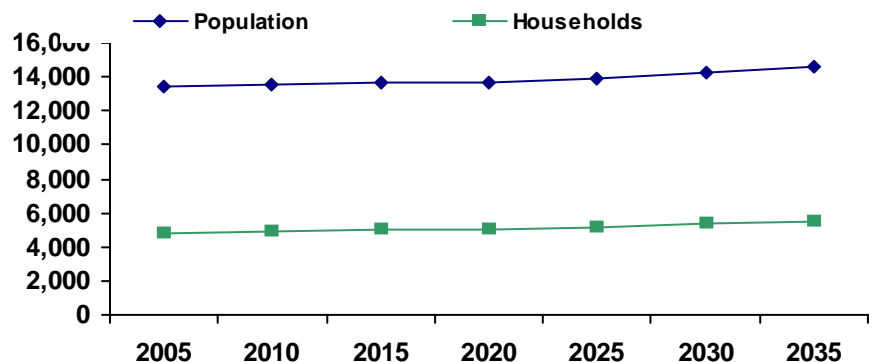

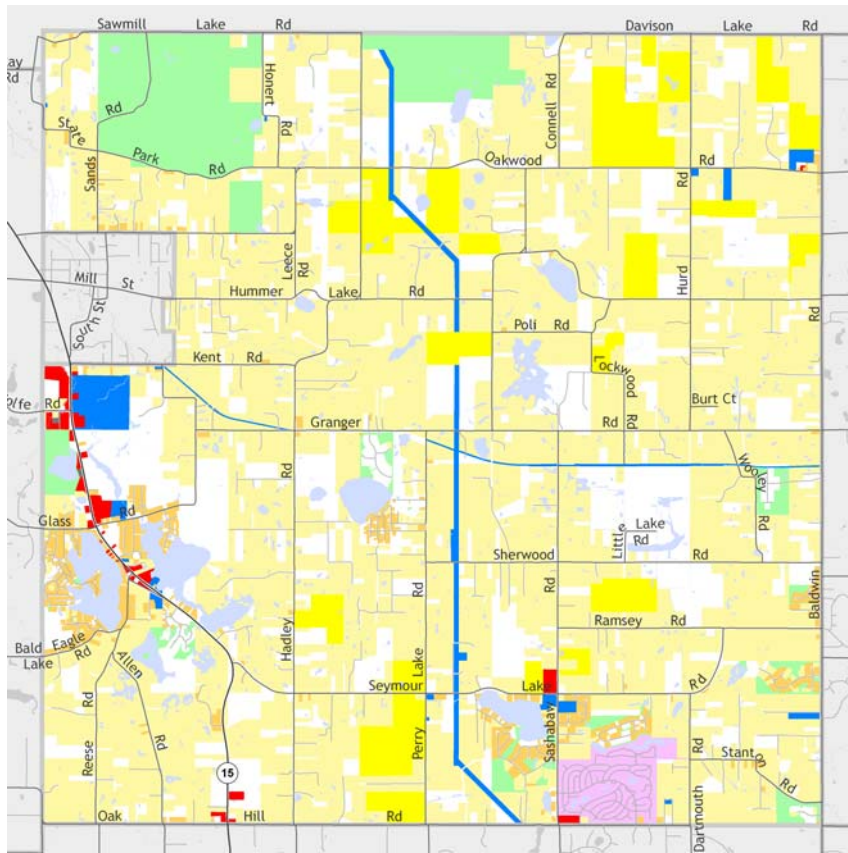
Population and Household Growth



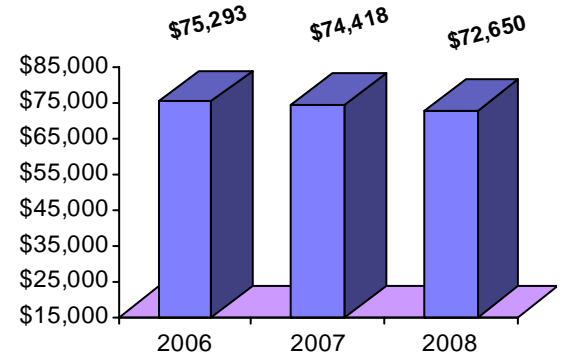
