The village of Holly exemplifies the romance of the 19th century Americana. Fifty three structures have been listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The downtown, which encompasses historic Battle Alley, draws tourists and shoppers from across the U.S. and Canada. Also located throughout the Village are ten churches, a library and five park and recreation facilities. Located in the Historic District of the village is Crapo Park with mature trees for picnics, playground area for children and a band shell. Water Works Park is located on the south side of the village is a 15 acre "green" park. Encompassing the Historic Power Station site, it is bordered by the Shiawasee River and Broad Street. This is the site of the annual canoe race and fishing tournament. Holly Village is a major center for historic railroad bus cars. An Oakland County Mainstreet community, it is the perfect combination of history meets future for residents and visitors alike.

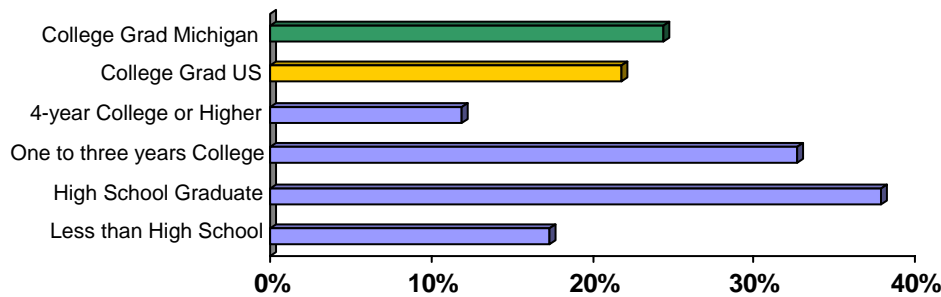

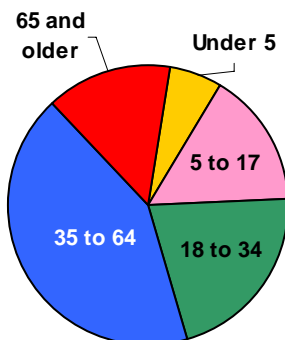

Educational Attainment of People Over 25 Years of Age

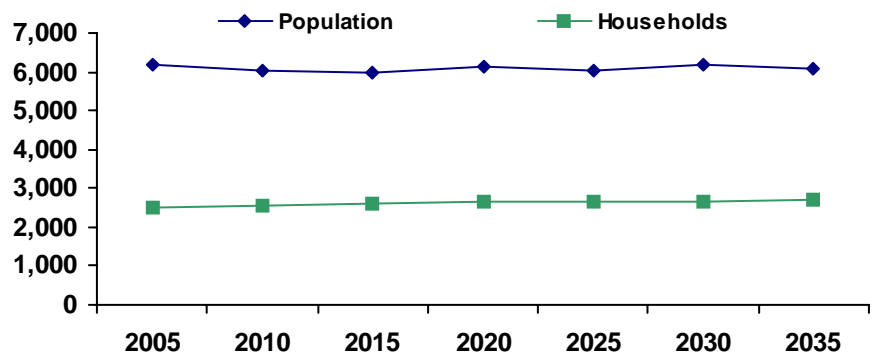


Colleges and Universities

Population by Age



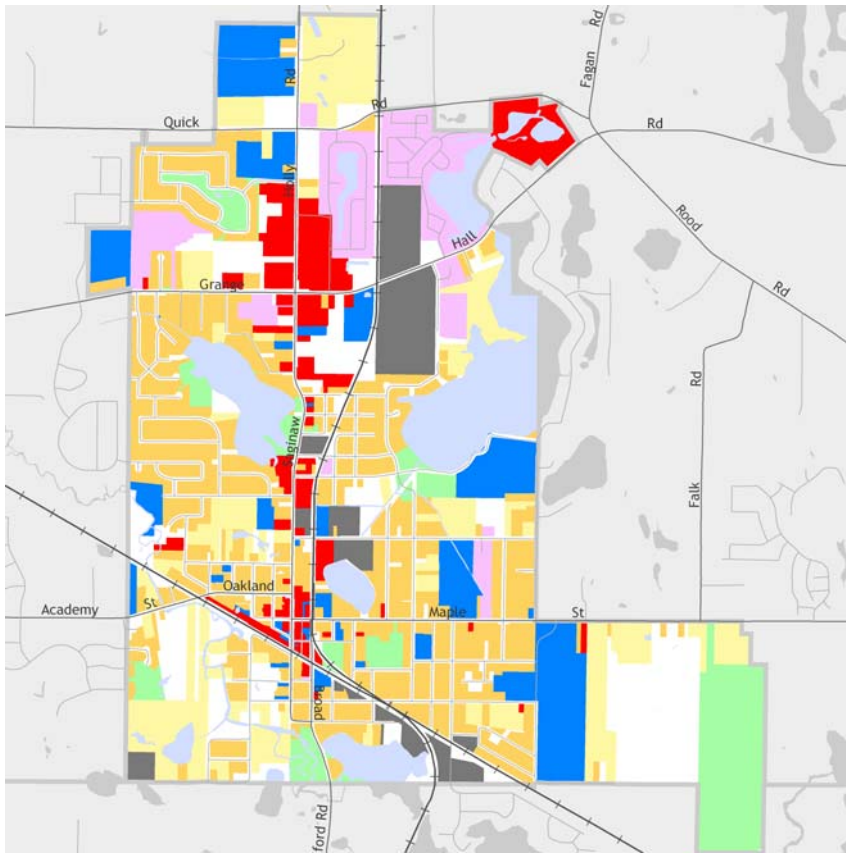
Population and Household Growth

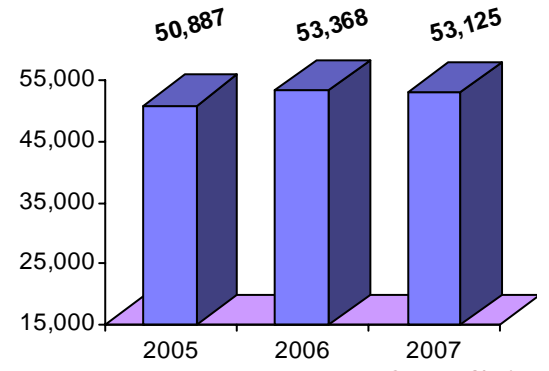
