The Village of Leonard is a small town tucked into the northeastern corner of Oakland County. Leonard Rowland founded this area in 1882. At that time, the Pontiac, Oxford and Northwestern Railroad rolled through this part of Addison Township. The old rail line has since been converted into the multi-use Polly Ann Trail, a 35 mile linear park which traverses some of the most beautiful rural landscapes and historic villages in Oakland County. The trail bisects Leonard, and attracts hikers, horse riders and experienced bicyclists.

For 54 years, the village has hosted an annual July Strawberry Festival. This tradition preserves Leonard's small town values for residents and visitors alike.

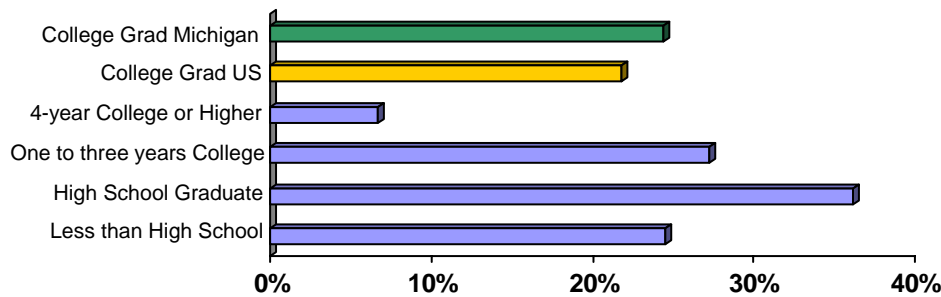

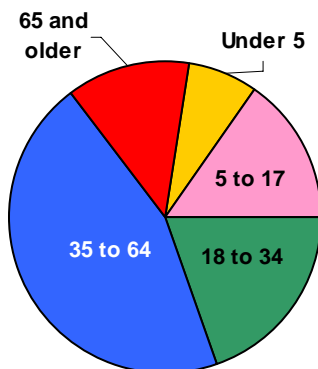

Educational Attainment of People Over 25 Years of Age

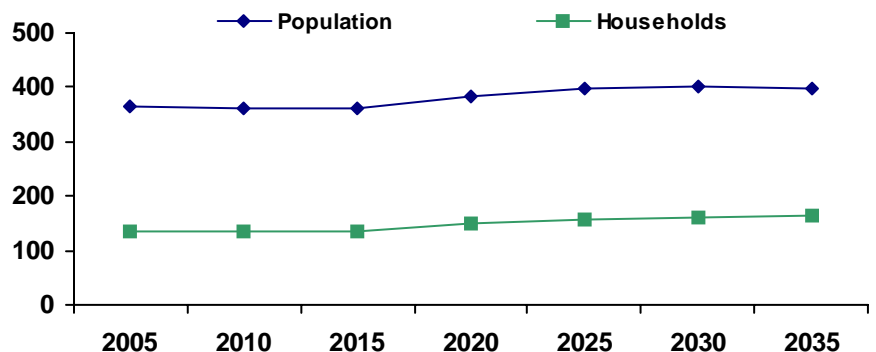


Colleges and Universities

Population and Household Growth

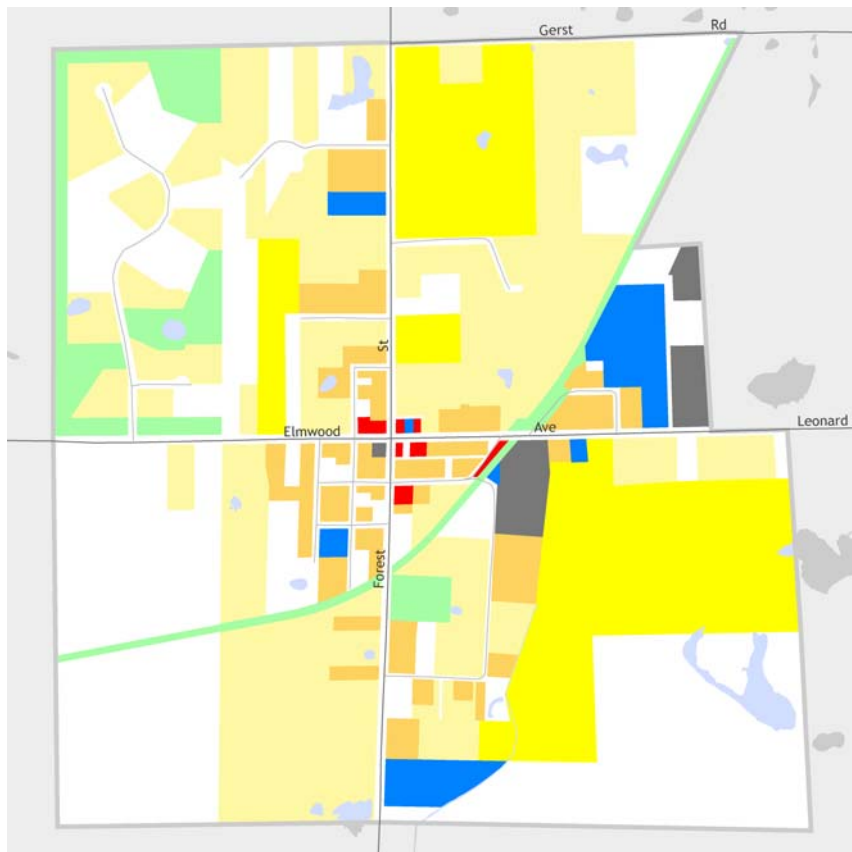

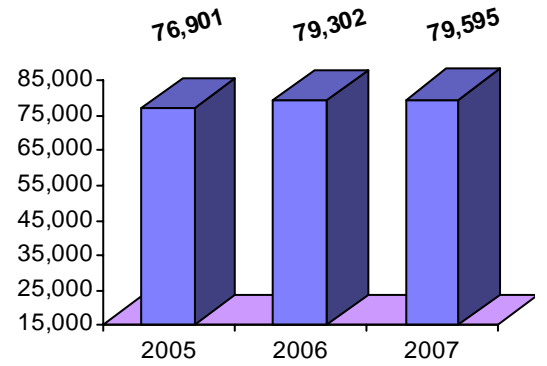
