Historically Distinctive

The City of Northville is a distinctive community of approximately 6500 residents located on the western fringe of the Detroit Metro area. The City was incorporated as a village in 1867 and as a city in 1955. The 2.2 square mile area is equally divided between Wayne and Oakland Counties and is about 30 minutes from downtown Detroit and 25 minutes from downtown Ann Arbor. The major thoroughfares of I-275 and M-14 are nearby. The Northville area is known for its rolling hills and attractive countryside. The City retains a small-town atmosphere with stately Victorian-era architecture in its Historic District and well-kept older homes built before the 1930s. A "walk to" downtown boasts of old-fashioned street lamps, benches, specialty shops, galleries, theaters, restaurants, businesses, and preserved landmarks. The City is part of the award winning Northville School District boasting math and reading MEAP scores 35% above state averages.

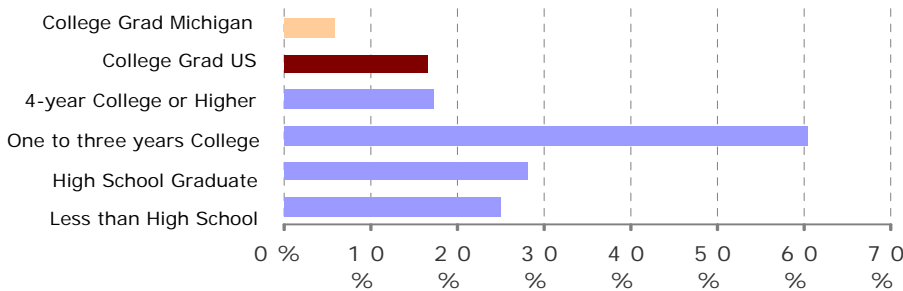

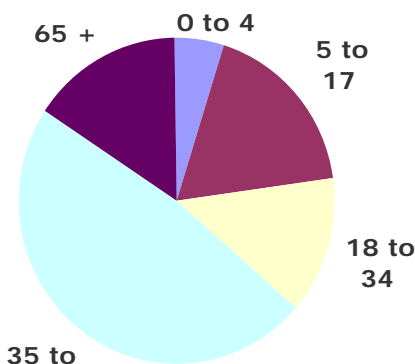
Educational Attainment of People Over 25 Years of Age

Population by Age



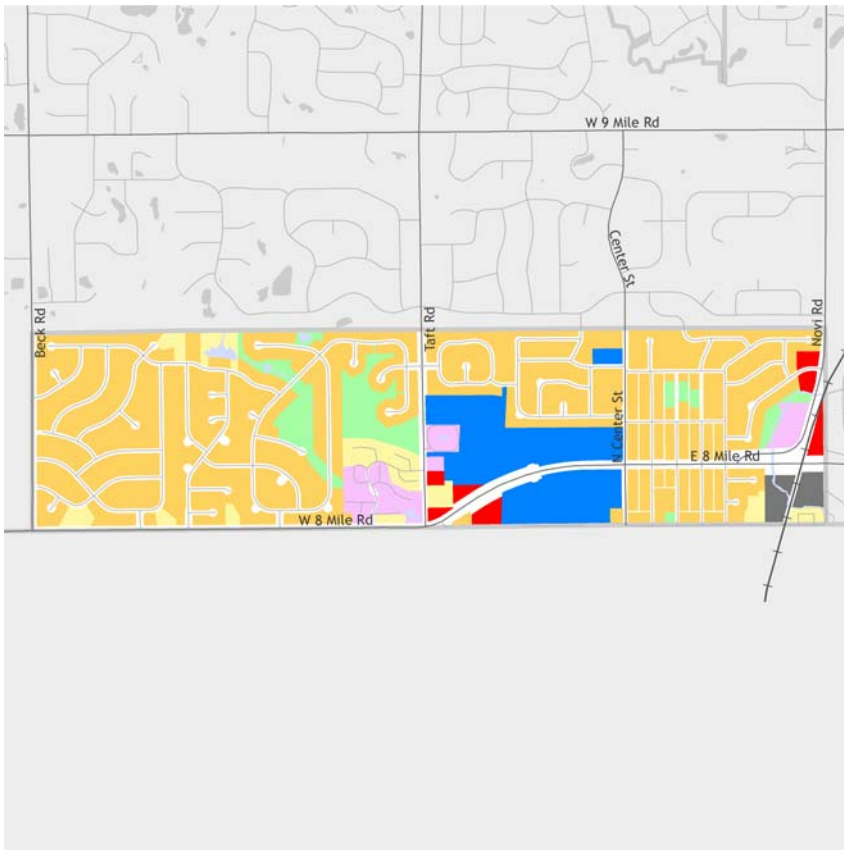

Population and Household Growth



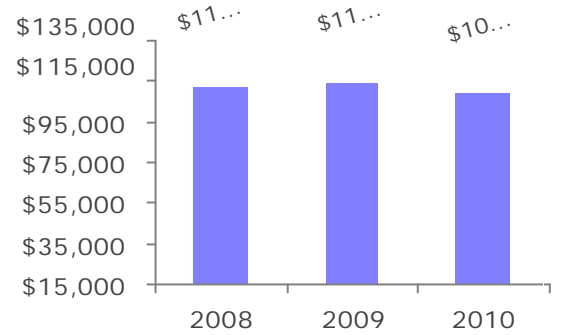
