Ortonville was founded by Amos Orton in 1848 when he built a dam on Kearsley Creek to provide power to his gristmill. Today over 1500 people live in the one-square-mile village and Amos Orton's mill lives on as home to the area's historical museum. Ortonville is a quiet, warm and friendly residential community located in the northern central portion of Oakland County. The village is proud of its history and listing in the state and historic register. The village is the largest incorporated area in the Township of Brandon. As an Oakland County Mainstreet community, the downtown district offers retail and business services, in addition to village offices, banking and community groups. There is an old-fashioned A&W Drive-in at the edge of town which invites visitors from neighboring communities to take a stroll down memory lane. Bisected by M-15, Ortonville has easy access to I-75 and I-69 providing connectivity to Pontiac and Flint, as well as other statewide destinations.

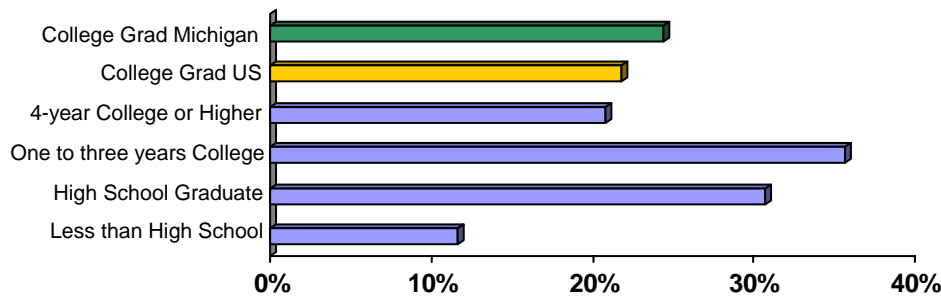

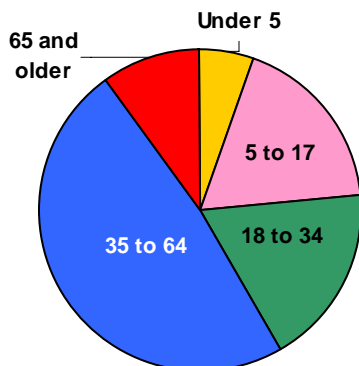

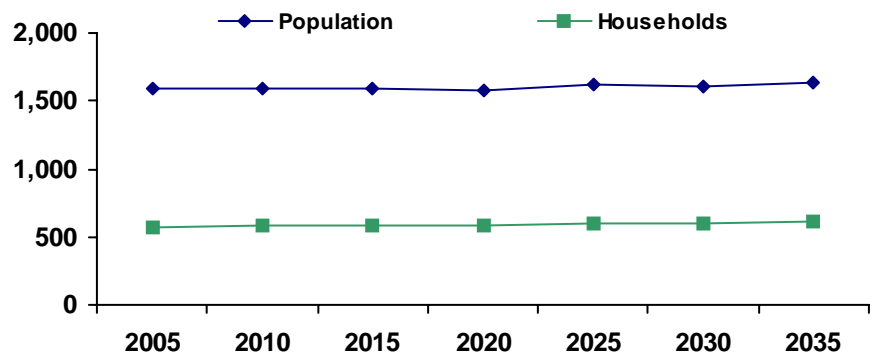
Educational Attainment of People Over 25 Years of Age



Population by Age



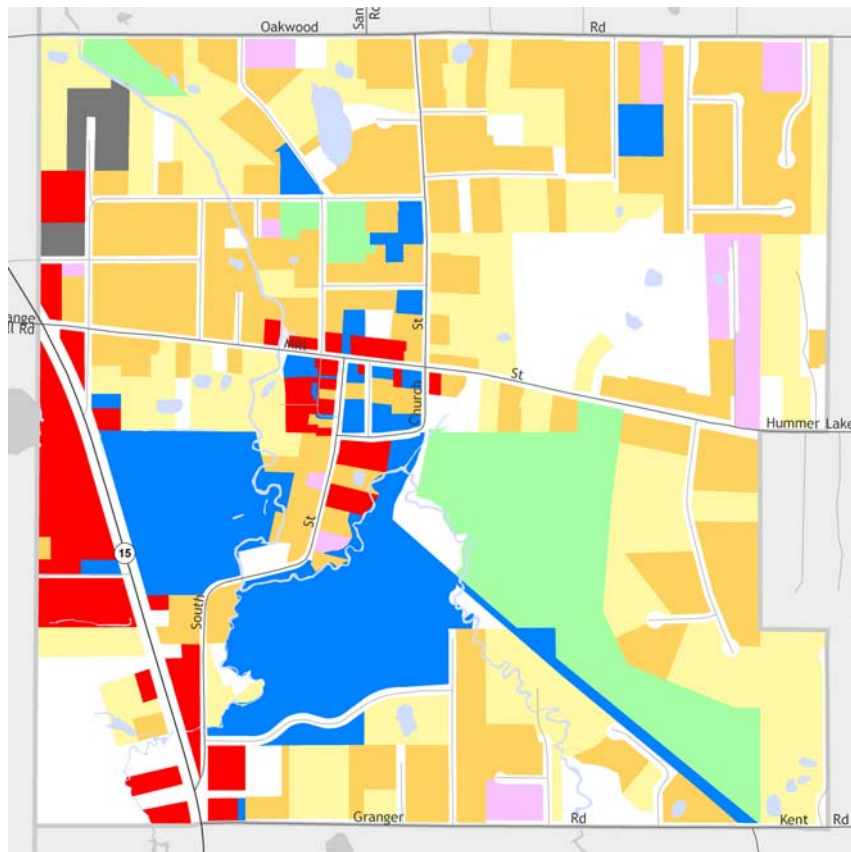
Population and Household Growth

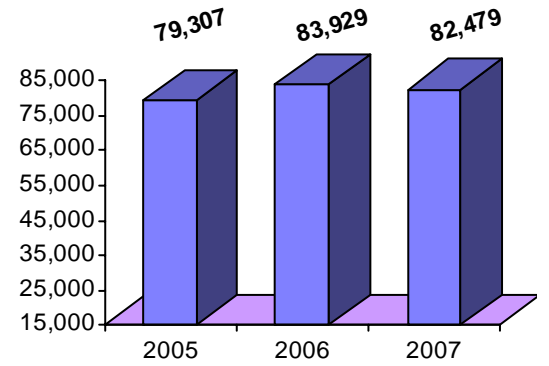
