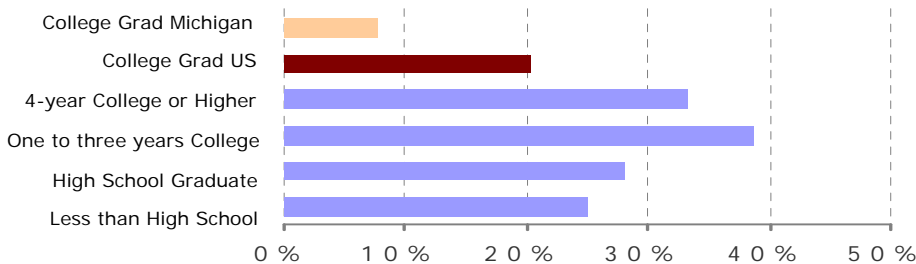

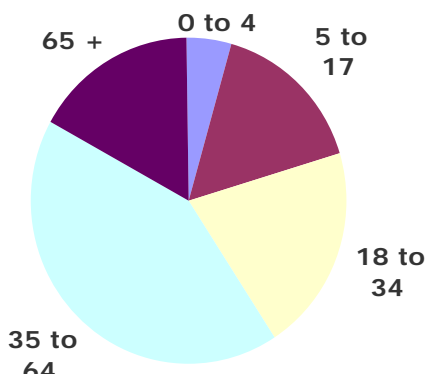

Population by Age



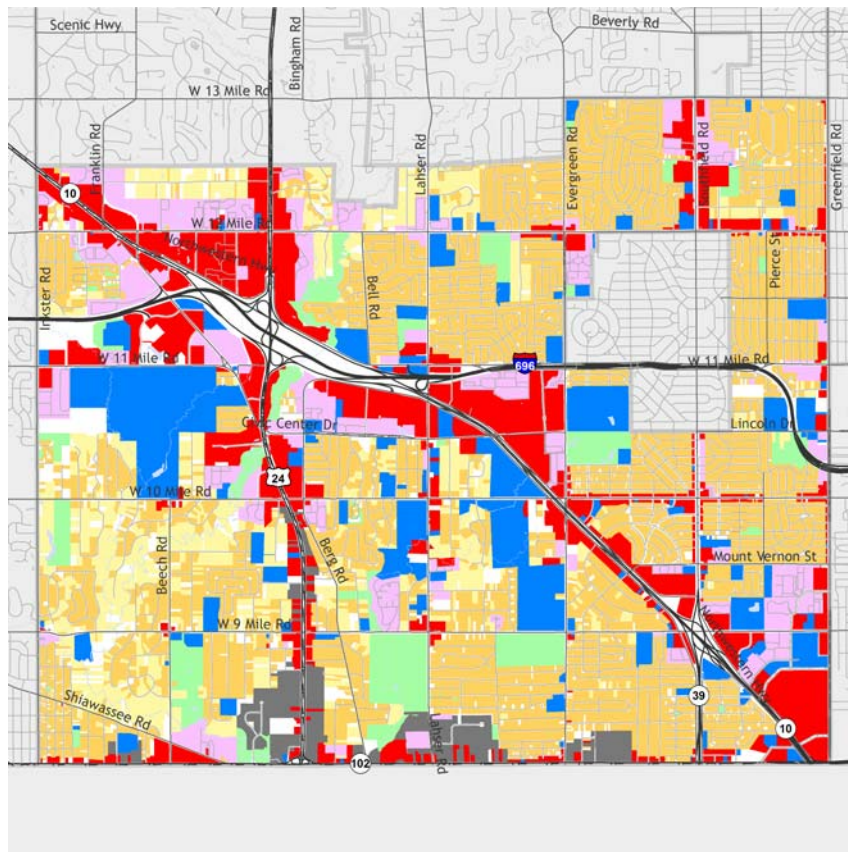

Population and Household Growth



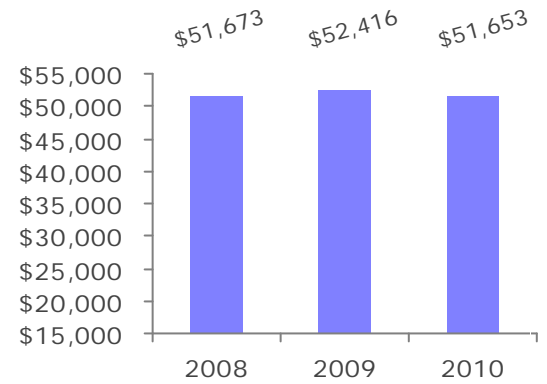
