

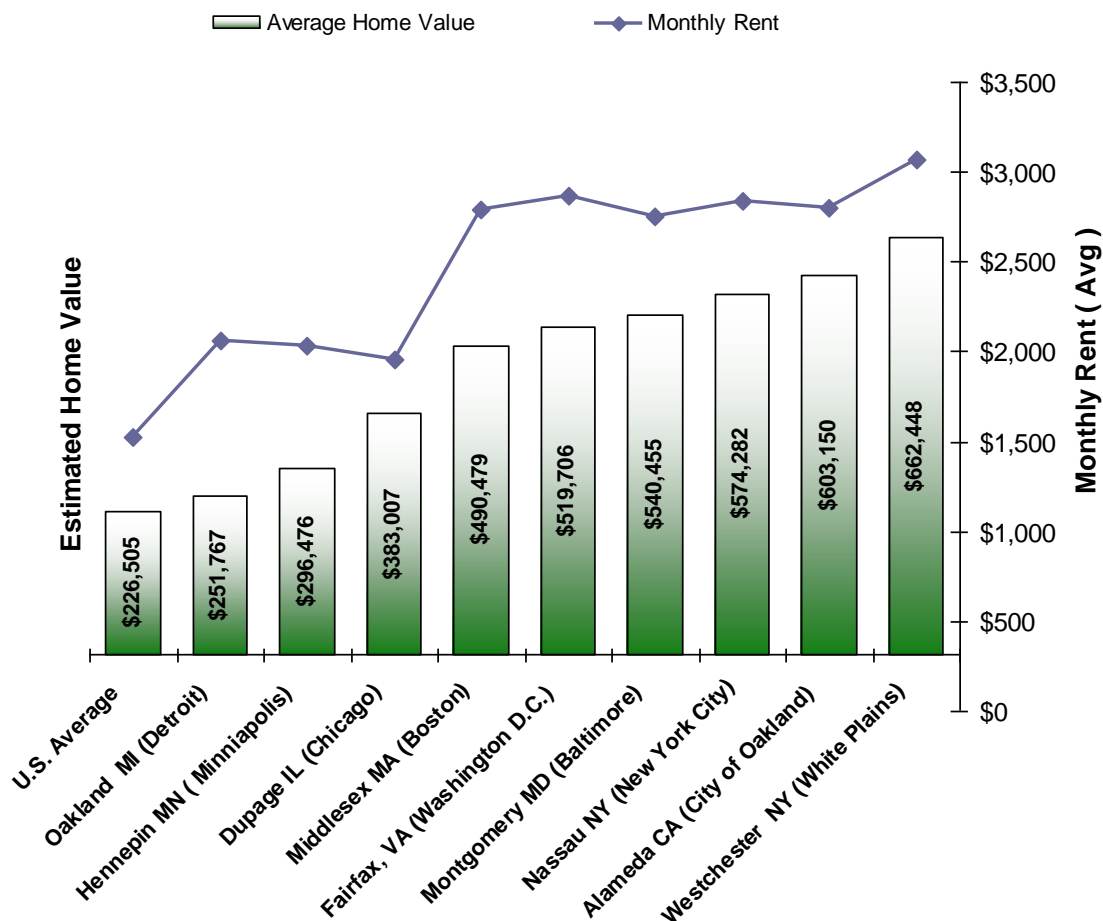
HOUSING COMPARISON

Oakland County vs. National Peers



- ◆ There are over a half million housing units in Oakland County encompassing the full spectrum of living styles from single-family residences, to town homes, to apartments and lofts, to modular-style homes.
- ◆ Oakland County's home ownership rate (69.1%) is higher than both the state of Michigan (63.7%) and the U.S. average (66.9%).
- ◆ Currently, the consumer price index for the Oakland County region falls nearly 6% below the national average.
