

# OTHER LOCAL AIRPORTS



## ***Detroit Metropolitan Airport (DTW)***

- ◆ Detroit Metro Airport, located west of Detroit, is the eleventh busiest airport in the country, with two passenger terminals, six runways, 145 gates, and an estimated economic impact of \$7.6 billion.
- ◆ Detroit Metro is the largest airport in Michigan, with every major airline providing daily service for businesses and residents. DTW also ranks first nationally in overall customer satisfaction of airports with 30 million passengers per year or more.
- ◆ The Detroit Metropolitan Airport ranked No.1 in overall customer satisfaction among large airports in the 2010 J.D.Power and Associates North America Airport Satisfaction study released in February.
- ◆ Most major hotels and convention centers in Oakland County run regularly scheduled shuttles to and from Detroit Metro Airport in addition to easily accessible taxi service.

## ***Bishop International Airport (FNT)***

- ◆ Located in Flint, thirty minutes north of Pontiac, Bishop International Airport began providing passenger airline service in 1993.
- ◆ With three runways, non-stop service to eleven major hubs and convenient parking, Bishop International Airport strives to make business and recreational flying easier.
- ◆ Airport amenities include a range of food and beverage options, skycap service, gift shop, shoeshine, a complimentary business center, and a visitor information center.

## ***Coleman A. Young International Airport (DET)***

(formerly Detroit City Airport)

- ◆ Located on Conner Street, North of I-94 and East of I-75, CAY-IA has an executive terminal and U.S. Customs. It is used primarily for air freight transportation and chartered passenger flights.

## ***Oakland's Troy (VLL) and Southwest (Y47) Airports***

- ◆ Located at the south end of Troy and the southwest corner of Oakland County respectively, these small Oakland County airports have one runway each and are used primarily for chartered passenger flights and air freight transportation.
