

## Finding a Missing Pet

The Oakland Pet Adoption Center offers these tips when trying to locate a lost pet.

- Call your local Animal Shelter or Police Department
- Post flyers at local businesses
- When offering a reward, do not put the dollar amount on your flyer
- Be wary of scams, never give someone money before they produce the animal
- If you need to arrange a meeting place for the exchange of your animal, use a local Police Department or City Offices

The Oakland Pet Adoption Center receives over 30 animals every day, more during spring and summer. When calling our office because you have lost your pet, you will be instructed to come to the Shelter. With that in mind, we are starting a new pilot program. We are going to list stray cats that have found their way to our Shelter. If you believe that one of the cats listed below is your pet, please contact the Shelter at (248) 391-4100 for more information. Again, you will be instructed to come to the Shelter to positively identify your pet.
