## Man, 80, dies after accident in Independence Township

An 80-year-old Clarkston man has died after authorities say the vehicle he was riding in was broadsided by another vehicle.

Albert Schwartz died Monday at Genesys Regional Medical Facility in Grand Blanc, according to a press release issued today by the Oakland County Sheriff's Office.

According to the release, Schwartz was riding Sunday morning in a 1997 Buick Park Avenue driven by a 77-year-old Clarkston resident when the crash occurred on southbound Sashabaw Road south of Flemings Lake in Independence Township.

After the crash, Schwartz was walking and talking and was taken to the hospital because of his age and to check for injuries.

The driver of the Buick was also injured and was taken to the hospital for treatment.

The driver of the other vehicle, a 2006 Jeep, was not injured.

The crash remains under investigation.
