## Distracted by cell phone, man dies in collision with limb

A 43-year-old Addison Township man died Wednesday afternoon when he ran into a 2-foot-thick limb lying across a road as he was distracted by his cell phone, according to investigators.

Eric LeFeuvre was driving on East Leonard Road west of Secord Lake Road when he hit the tree branch 11:45 a.m., according to the Oakland County Sheriff's office.

Children playing nearby told investigators the tree had fallen about 15 minutes before the crash.

Accident reconstructionists did not find any signs that LeFeuvre had used his brakes before part of the tree went through the windshield of his 1999 GMC Yukon.

LeFeuvre, who was not wearing a seatbelt, was pronounced dead at the scene.

Alcohol does not appear to be a factor in the crash.
