Highland Township guard to be arraigned on charges of impersonating officer

A Highland Township security guard is expected to be arraigned Monday on charges that he impersonated an officer when he pulled over several vehicles for speeding, the Oakland County Sheriff's Office said.

Deputies responded to a call around 11 p.m. Saturday to investigate a suspicious person in the area of North Tipsico Lake and Murray Hill roads. They found a security guard who had an illegal flashing red light on his car. He was pulling over vehicles for speeding and to get identification of those who he said did not belong in the area, according to the sheriff's office.

The suspect was wearing a uniform that included a gun belt. He was taken to the Oakland County Jail on a charge of impersonating an officer.
