Cop calls

Butcher knife assault

Deputies from the Oakland County Sheriff's Office Lyon Post arrested a female shortly after 2 a.m. Aug. 2 after the woman threatened another woman with two butcher knives.

The incident took place at Haas Lake Park in Lyon Township.

According to police reports, the incident began when several people were seated around a campfire. One female pushed another female during a verbal argument. The female who pushed the second female went to her camper/trailer and returned with two large butcher knives, which she had concealed behind her back.

The woman and her friend were in fear and locked themselves in their camper/trailer, and then called police.

Deputies arrived on scene and found the woman seated outside the trailer on the picnic table. Deputies recovered the two large butcher knives, and arrested the woman. She was taken to the Oakland County jail.
