

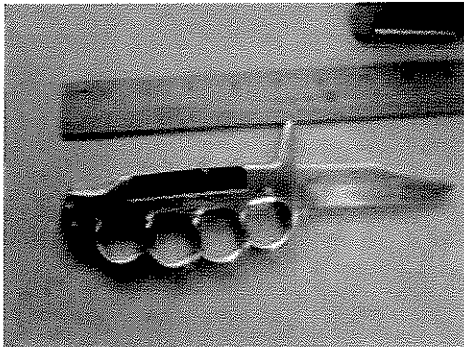

Flint teen arrested with knife with brass knuckle-handle in Oakland County District Court

OAKLAND COUNTY, Michigan — A Flint teen was charged with possession of a dangerous weapon after allegedly being caught with a knife with a brass knuckle-handle in Oakland County District Court in Troy.

Breanna T. Calvin, 18, was making a court appearance for a probation violation hearing at about 8:20 a.m. Nov. 13 when the weapon was detected as her purse passed through an X-ray machine, according to the Oakland County Sheriff's Department.

The knife measured 9-inches long total with a 3 1/2-inch blade, according to the department.

She was arraigned and released on a \$10,000 personal bond. Her next court date is unknown. Possession of a dangerous weapon is a four-year felony.
