Boy threatens classmate with knife

A 13-year-old student at Geisler Middle School, located in the 16400 block of Pontiac Trail, allegedly produced a hunting knife and threatened another student last week, according to Oakland County Sheriff's Department Commerce Substation deputies.

Deputies got the call and responded to

the school to investigate the incident on Monday, Sept. 8. The juvenile responsible was taken into custody and lodged at Children's Village. He was assigned a \$500 cash bond and was ordered to not have any contact with the reported victim on or off school property.

According to Sheriff's Department reports, the suspect pulled the hunting knife, said to be 4-and-a-half-inches in length, and allegedly held it to the classmate's throat. He then reportedly threatened to kill the the classmate.

Emergency protocols were followed at the school, the incident was investigated and the weapon was confiscated.
