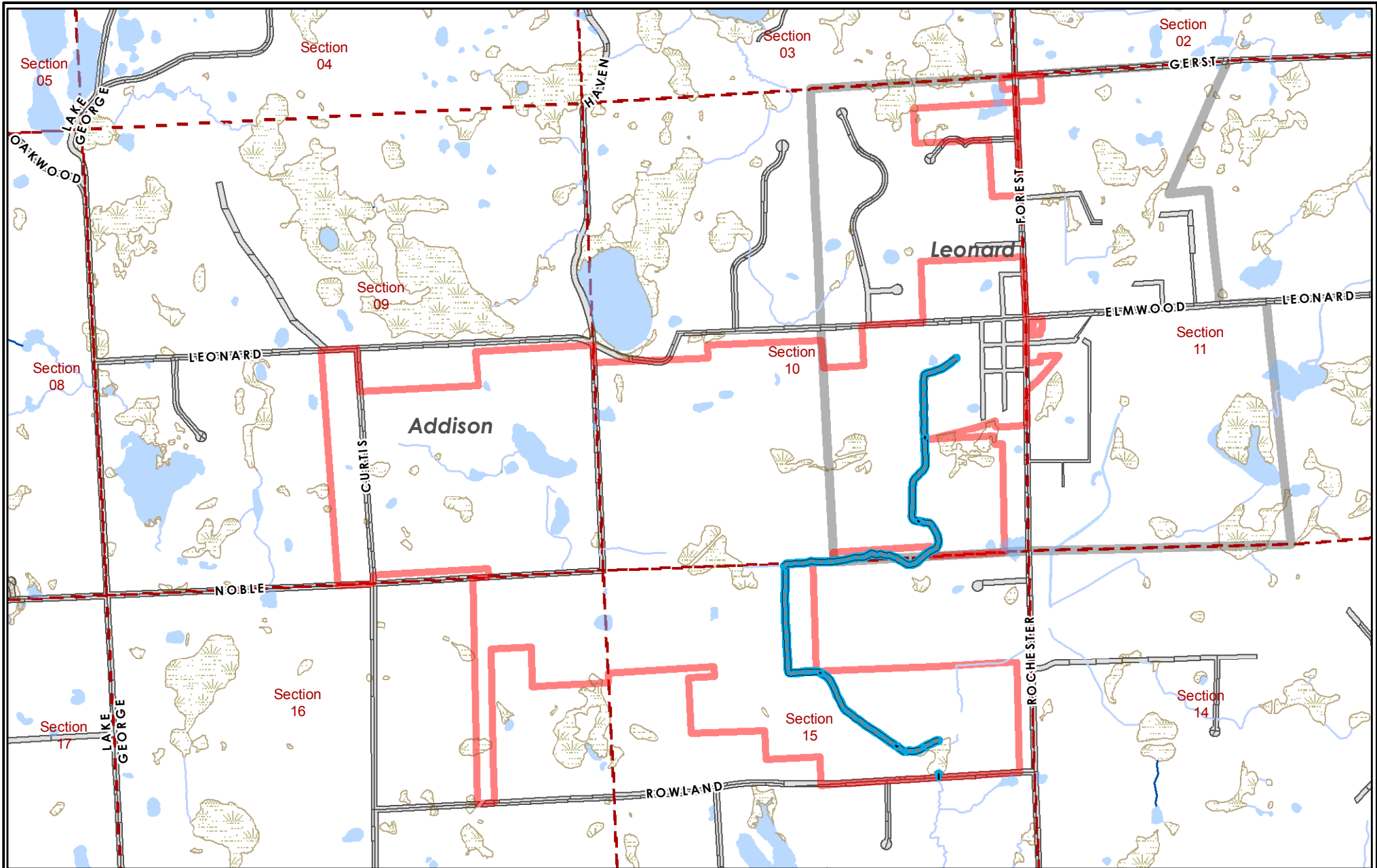


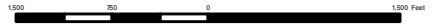
## Clark County Drain

The Clark Drain was established in 1902 in accordance with Michigan Drain law in effect at that time. The Drain was established by cleaning out and widening an existing creek. The cost of the work was \$3,138.21. The Clark Drain collects runoff from 690 Acres and outlets into a natural watercourse south of Rowland Road.
