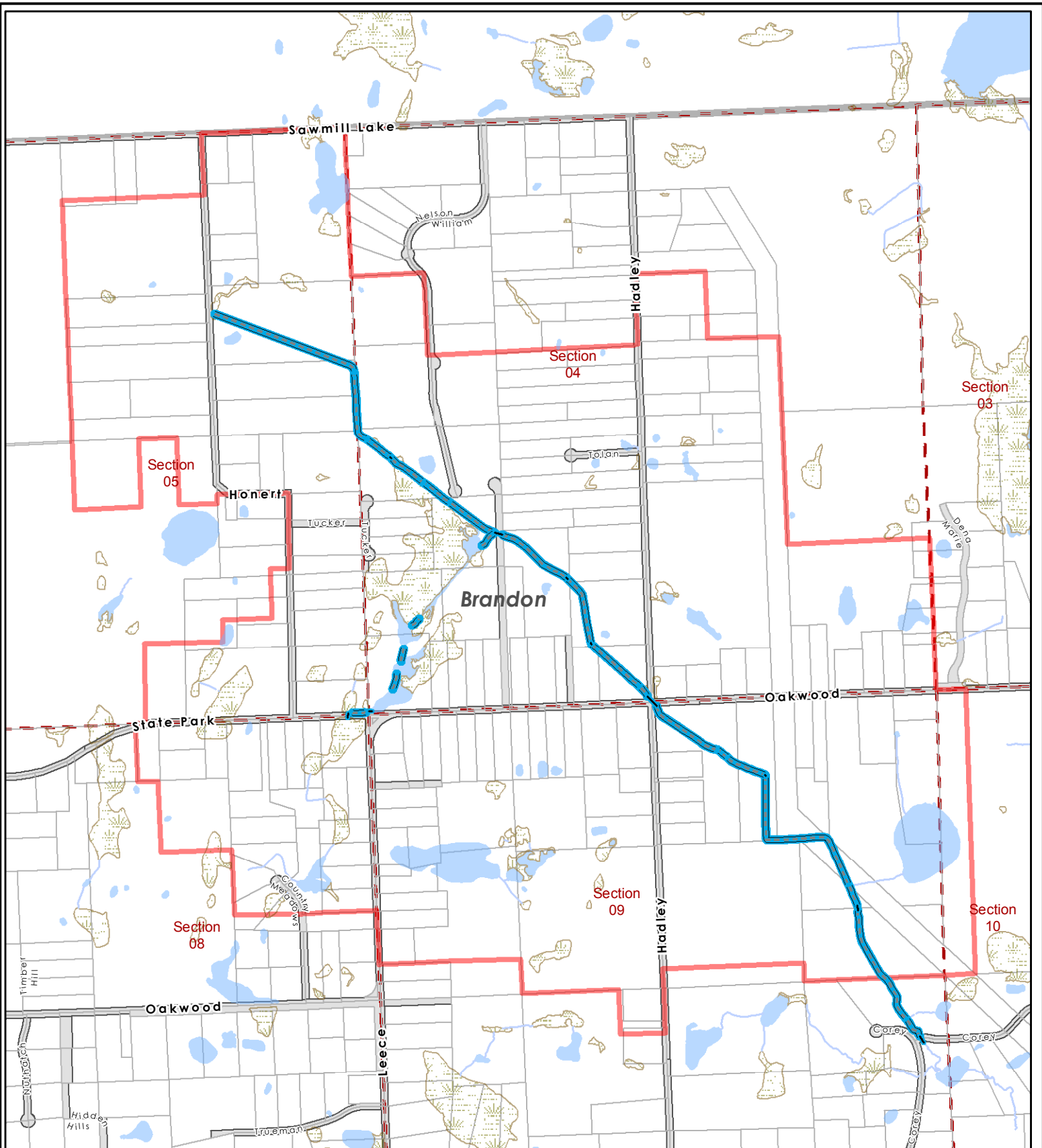


The Craft Drain is a Chapter 4 drain established in 1902. The drain has its outlet in the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 9 in the Township of Brandon. From the outlet the drain extends northwesterly through the E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of section 9 and crosses into section 4 in the vicinity of the intersection of Hadley and Oakwood Roads; thence continuing northwesterly through the W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of section 4 to the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence southwesterly to its upper terminus in section 8 near the intersection of Park Road and Oakwood Road. Also a branch extending northwesterly from the main branch, from a point in the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 4 and extending northwesterly to Honert Road. The drain was constructed in 1903 and was extended 640 feet in 1943. The drain was constructed in open ditch and has a total length of 12,751 feet.
