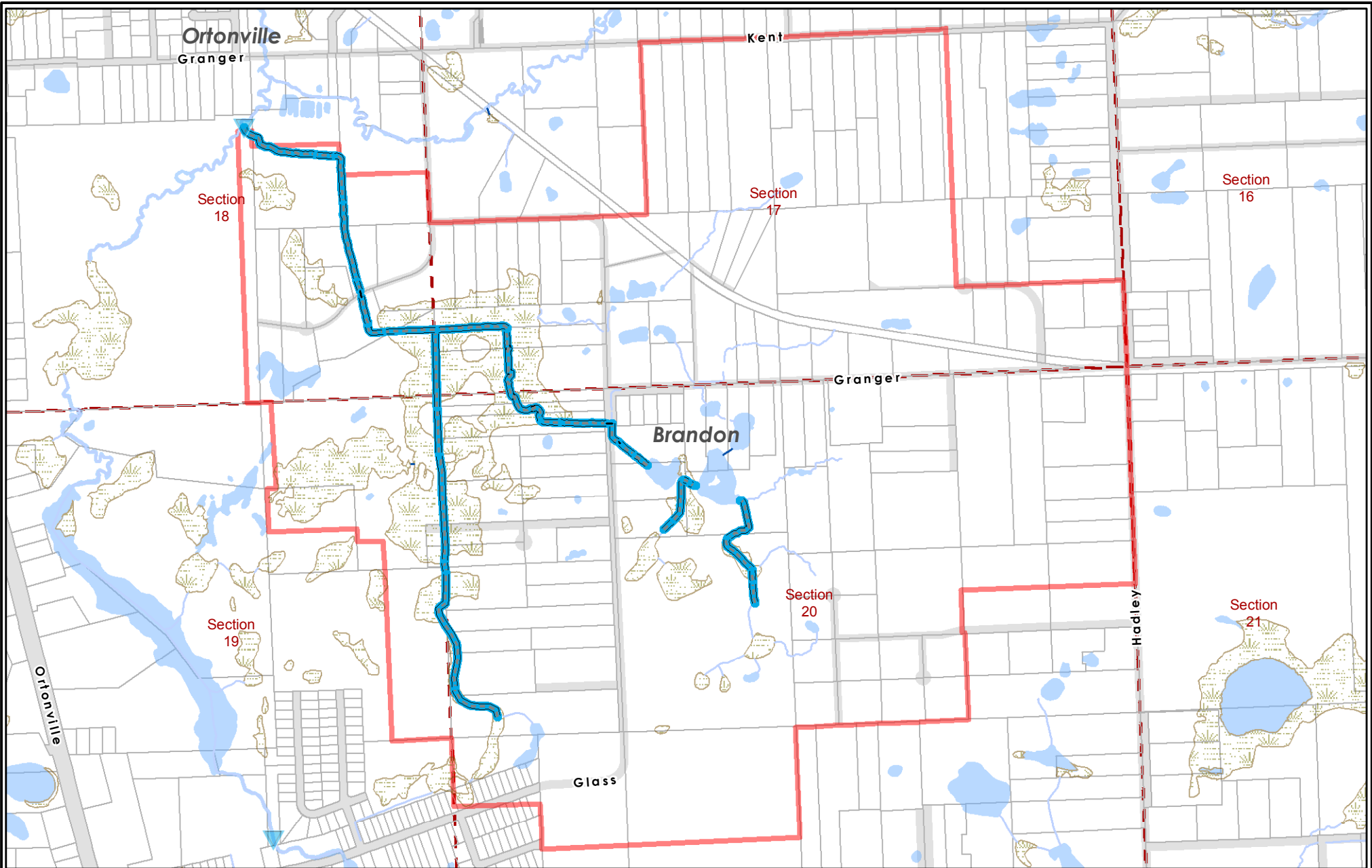


The Kent Drain is a Chapter 4 drain and was established in 1908. It has its outlet in a natural water course in Brandon Township. From its outlet, the drain extends southeasterly to its upper terminus. The main drain is 5,662 feet in length. Branch "A" extends southeasterly from the main line from a point 5,176 feet upstream from the outlet of the main drain. Said point is located east of Glass Road and south of Granger Road. Branch "A" is 1800 feet in length. Branch "B" extends south from the main drain for a distance of 3,130 feet.
