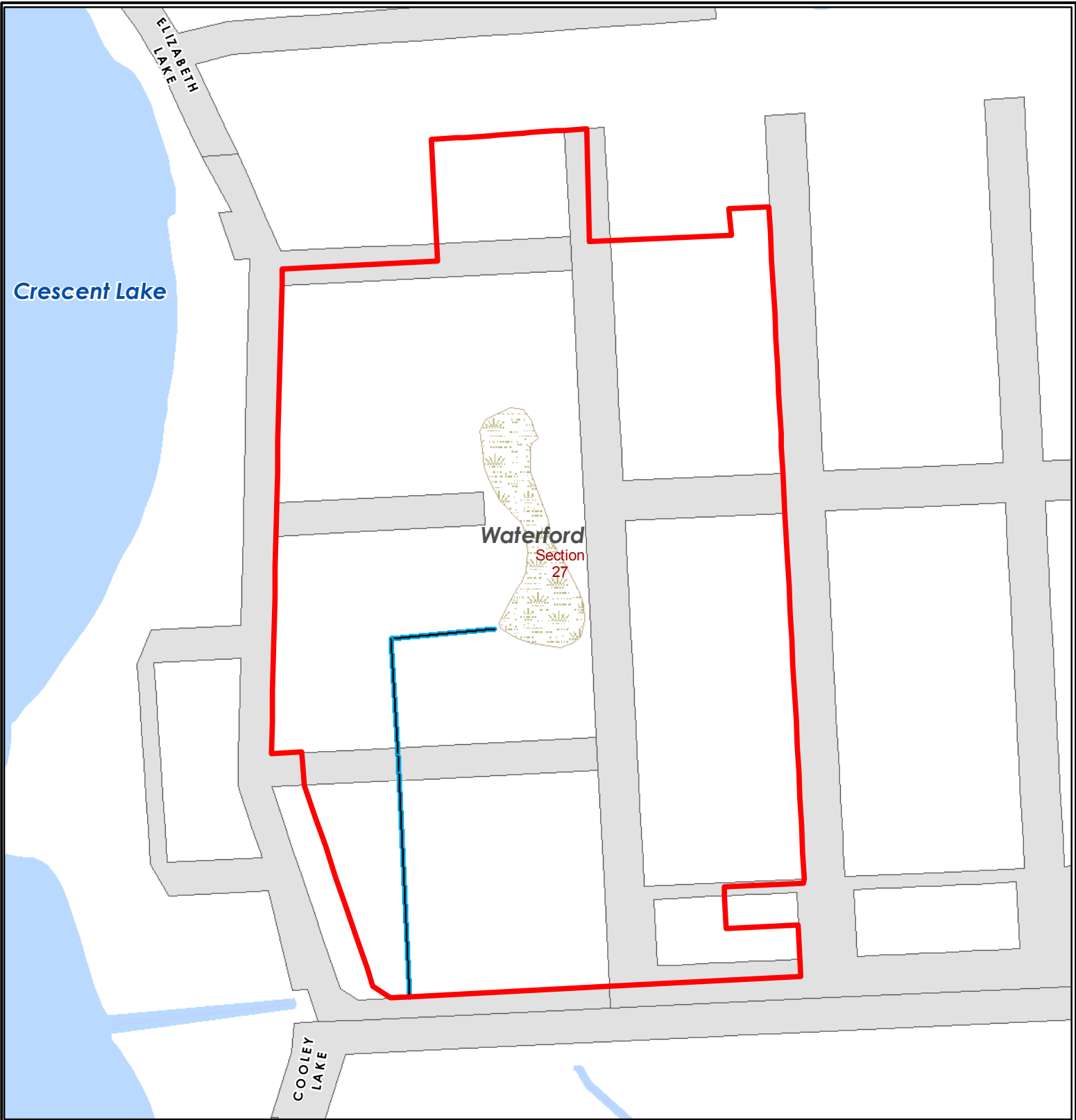


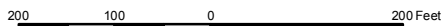
The McIvor Drain was established in 1951. It has its outlet in a 36 inch diameter line on the north side of Elizabeth Lake Road approximately 100 feet east of Crescent Lake Road. From its outlet the drain extends northerly 543 feet; thence easterly 157 feet to a pond. The drain is constructed of 12 inch diameter concrete pipe and has a total length of 700 feet.
