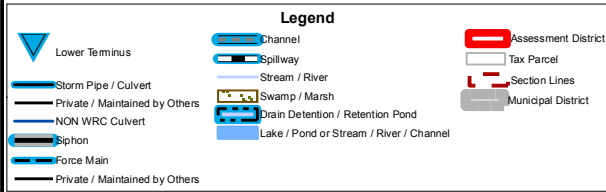
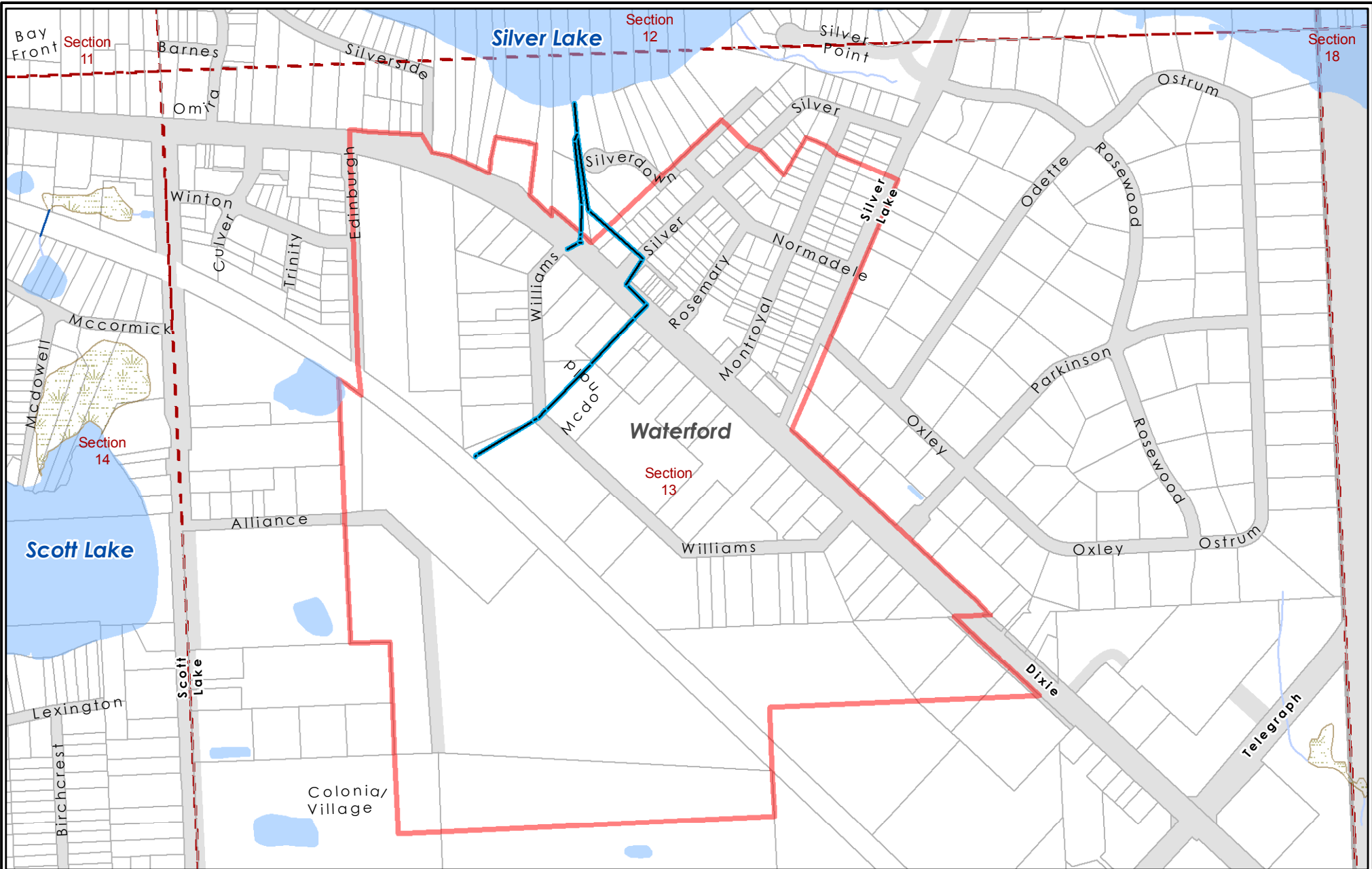


The Silvercrest Drain is an enclosed Chapter 4 Drain and was established in 1943. It has its outlet in Sliver Lake in the Township of Waterford. From its outlet, the drain extends southerly to a point approximately 630 feet south of the shore line of Sliver Lake; thence southeasterly approximately 90 feet to the center of Sliver Lake Boulevard; thence continuing southeasterly in an alley east of Dixie Highway 230 feet to the intersection of the alley with Silver Circle; thence southwesterly in Silver Circle 135 feet to the east side of Dixie Highway; thence southeasterly along the east side of Dixie Highway a distance of 135 feet; thence southwesterly a distance of 1106 feet, crossing Dixie Highway, Williams Avenue and continuing to its upper terminus on the east side of the Grand Trunk Railroad. The drain has a total length of 2,324 feet, of which 2,068 feet is enclosed.
