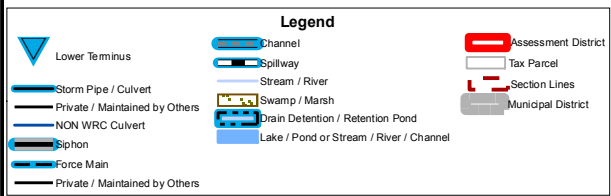
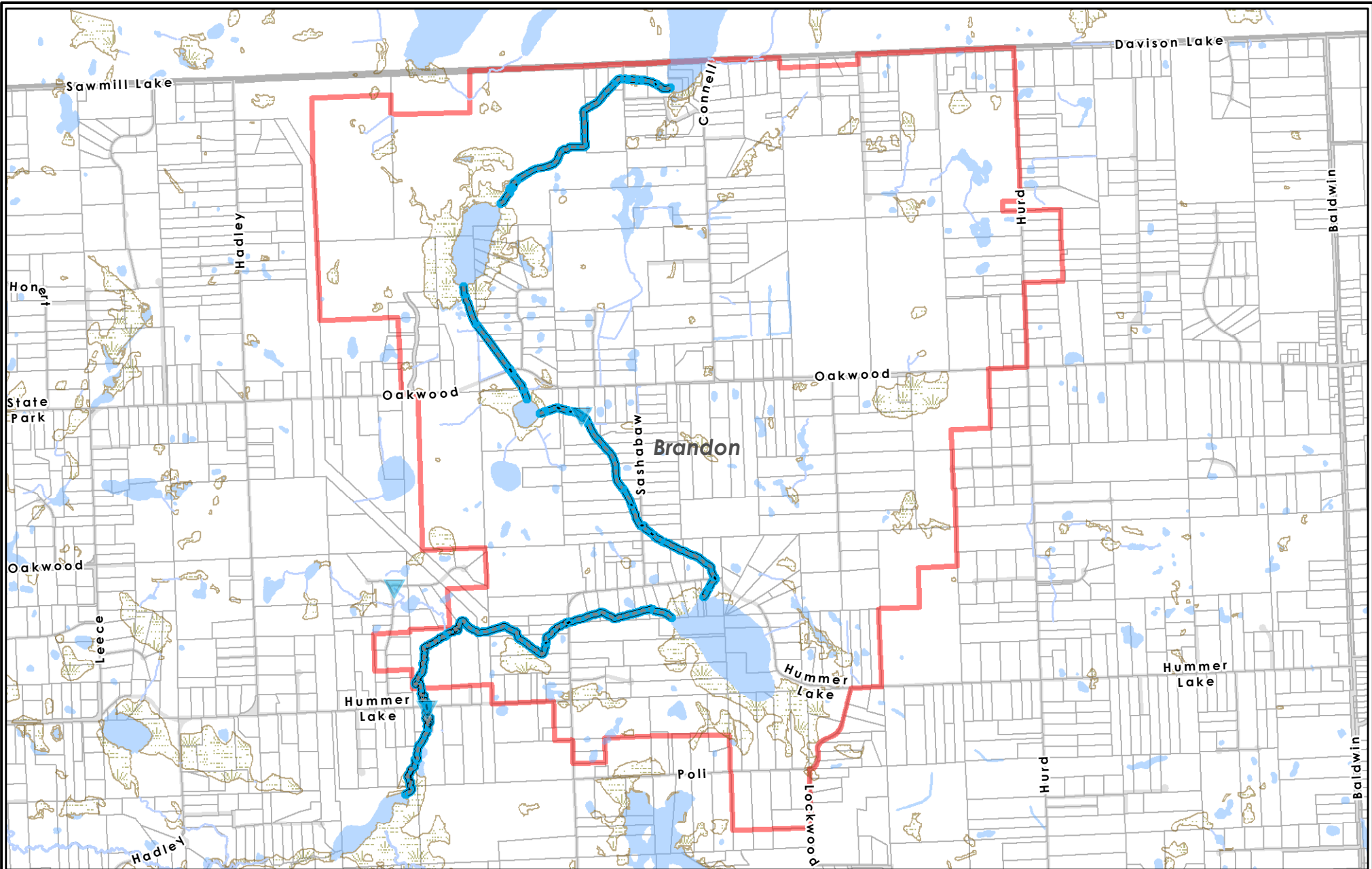


The Woolman- Wells Drain is an open ditch Chapter 4 drain and was established in 1906. It has its outlet in a natural water course in the Township of Brandon; thence extending easterly 4200 feet to the west shoreline of Hummer Lake; thence continuing from a point on the north shore of Hummer Lake in the vicinity of Hummer Lake Road and extending northwesterly for a distance of 4800 feet to the south shore of Crossway Lake; thence continuing from the north shore of Crossway Lake and extending northwesterly for a distance of 2200 feet to the shore of Mud Lake; thence continuing from a point on the northeast shore of Mud Lake and extending northeasterly to the south shore of Davidson Lake. There is a control structure in the drain located near the outlet of Hummer Lake. The drain has a total length of 17,027 feet.
